Museum drive gains momentum

MARKHAM - "Most encouraging, most encouraging, indeed", was the way museum curator, John Lunau, explained the response to the cabin-moving project. A total of \$1,050 of the \$3,000 objective has been contributed to relocate the 1874 settler's cabin on the grounds of the Markham District Historical Society Society.

Donations to preserve and display this part of Markham's history are being collected by Mr. Lunau, Mayor Alma Walker, the Markham Township Office, the Economist and Sun, and The Tribune.

Mayor Alma Walker, a staunch supporter of this community venture stresses that contributions of any amount are gratefully accepted and are tax-deductible. Those donating \$10 or more receive a commemorative plate from the Society. These are manufactured in Collingwood and may be purchased separately for \$2.00 with the proceeds being directed towards the development of the museum.

Several individuals and businesses have provided products and services without charge to help assure success of this endeavour. One of these is Primeau Block, who are supplying blocks for the cabin's foundation. Mr. D. Nastic whose fence and grounds must be altered to facilitate the move has been very co-operative.

Mr. Lunau points out that over one-third of
