14-day jail sentence

CLAREMONT - A 25 year old Claremont man, convicted for a second time on a charge of driving while impaired, was sentenced to 14 days in jail, the minimum penalty under the law.

Additional charges included - failure to provide evidence of car insurance and driving while discharged.

In addition to the jail term, the accused's licence to drive was suspended for 12 months plus a \$75 fine or 14 days concurrent.
