Sold drugs—Two youths charged

MARKHAM - Two Markham youths were sentenced to two months in jail each, Tuesday, when they appeared before Judge M.A. Charles in Richmond Hill Court on drug trafficking charges.

David Grunski, 17, and Mark Hegum, 18, had been in custody two weeks awaiting sentence after

entering guilty pleas.

They were charged, April 4, with possession of Methamphetamine and its salts (speed) for the purpose of trafficking. Both lived at 19 Robinson Street at the time.

In imposing sentence, Judge Charles commented that in a case like this, the interests of the accused

are subservient to those of the state; the most important principle in sentencing any person is deterrent. I owe a duty to society to impose such a sentence
