## Eldred King Mayoralty candidate envisioning a 'dynamic community'

**WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE** - "I have no personal ambitions except to see that fair decisions are made in forming policies vital to the birth and future of Whitchurch-Stouffville." Farmer-businessman-politician, Eldred King, at 43, the youngest candidate for mayor of the new municipality was outlining his reasons for entering the four-way race.

Mr. King, a member of Markham Township Council since 1968, lives in the Stouffville area with his wife, Beulah, and three sons, Jeffrey, 10, Rodney, 8, and Jan, 6. He acts more as a livestock 'broker', rather than a farmer, and was transporting a Holstein herd to Hungary at the time of this interview.

He got his political feet wet as a member of the Dickson's Hill School Board and later served on the Markham Township School Area 2 Board for four years. Prior to the formulation of the York County Board of Education, he was chosen as representative of the ISOC Committee.

At the age of 6, he left his birth place in Scarborough for Markham Township. For 30 years he has lived

on the farm which he purchased from his father in 1960. The mayoralty candidate was educated at Melville Public School and Stouffville Dist. High School and was active in the Junior Farmers program.

Two of his 14 years with the York County Holstein Association were as president. Other organizations to which he belongs are the York County Soils and Crop Development Association, York County Milk Committee and the Markham Fair Board. His family attends Stouffville United Church of which he is a member of the Board of Stewards.

"Does the 'wedding' of the urban-suburbanite and the farmer pose any problems?" "No, not in the least, in fact this forced integration of life styles should provide diversity for a very dynamic community. But policies affecting them must be implemented correctly and by an in-tune representation."

As a member of the Planning Board and Chairman of the Finance Committee, Eldred King had many thoughts on these subjects. "Planning in the larger municipal unit will now allow for a total rather than a patchwork concept." "Before the first budget is approved by the Regional Council, I would want it tested in each municipality to avoid any possible injustices."

"What advantage does he carry into the mayoralty race?" "My experience in Markham Township, a rapidly developing area has given me the opportunity for experience in planning and financing that would have escaped me as a member of the Stouffville, or Whitchurch Councils."

### Bids for regional seat

**MARKHAM** - Two representatives from the new Town of Markham Area will be elected to a seat on the Regional Council.

One of those candidates is Jim Jongeneel, current councillor in Ward 2, Twp. of Markham. He resides at 11 Millmar Court, Thornhill with his wife, Veronica Jean, two daughters, Elizabeth Anne, 3, Suzanne, 1½ and a pet Labrador named 'Vim'. Mr. Jongeneel is a vice-president and director of the firm, John C.L. Allen Limited, Toronto, where he serves as a stockbroker and investment adviser.

An ardent outdoor sportsman, Jim's extracurricular activities include work with the Junior Chamber of Commerce, Toronto, membership in the Toronto Board of Trade, the Queen's Club and the North York Hunt Club. He owns a piece of farm property in adjacent Whitchurch.

Planks in his platform include - a more equitable assessment system to provide residents with some relief from high tax increases; to spread education taxes over a larger area by obtaining funds from Provincial and Federal sources; implementation of a Go-Train service rather than buses; immediate construction of Hwy. 404; strengthening the Park Committee's role in obtaining new recreation and park facilities from developers at the time of subdivision rather than charge a part of this cost to present residents; to establish economic guidelines for the employment of Regional staff personnel and a co-operative plan to eliminate duplication of functions throughout the various municipal administrative staffs.

## Candidate is Ryerson graduate

**WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE** - Stephen Kettle, while a comparative newcomer to Stouffville, has, for the past year, been a familiar figure at village council meetings. He is one of the

few who attends meetings regularly. This association plus a devoted interest in the affairs of the municipality, has prompted him to seek election in Ward 5, Oct. 5. Mr. Kettle and his wife,

Beverley, reside on Loretta Crescent South. They moved here in Nov. 1969.

Born in Toronto, Stephen received his elementary and secondary school

education there. Later, he graduated in Business Administration from Ryerson and now holds a position of office manager for a mechanical contracting firm. He is 26.
