### Split land development opposed by owner

**STOUFFVILLE** - The splitting of the Booth property into separated phases of development, has brought an objection from one representative owner, Mrs. Betty Stuart, Main Street East.  
 Mrs. Stuart, accompanied by town planner, Lloyd Thompson of Orangeville, attended a meeting of council, Nov. 19.  
 The land in question lies on the south side of Main Street with an entrance from College Street near Summitview School.  
 Mr. Thompson said that while his client was not necessarily ready to proceed with any build up on the site, the value of the property would be lessened by placing one part in Phase 1 and another in Phase 2.  
 About 64 acres is involved, Mr. Thompson said.  
 Reeve Ken Laushway explained that the land in question had been considered by the Metro Planning Board as far back as 12 to 15 years ago. He wondered why representation had not been made at the public meeting, Sept. 10.  
 Both parties claimed no knowledge of the advertised date.
