STOUFFVILLE—Last respects were paid by family and friends, Jan. 2, at a service conducted by Rev. James Carder from O'Neill's Funeral Home, for Dennis White, a well-known, respected farmer in the area most of his life and resident of Stouffville for the past 4 years.

Mr. White, who passed away Dec. 30, was born in Newtonbrook, 76 years ago, the son of Thomas and Georgina White.

In April, 1923, he married Myrtle Dennis, daughter of Fred and Lillie Dennis, Lemonville.

Mr. and Mrs. White first lived and farmed at Victoria Square before moving to property in the Gormley area. Four years ago, they took up residence on Church St., Stouffville.

Mr. White, a World War I veteran, saw service with the 116 Battalion. He was a member of the Canadian Legion and, during his lifetime was affiliated with Thornhill and Unionville Anglican Churches.
