**Sixty volunteers needed to assist disabled riders**

STOUFFVILLE — "We have a desperate need for 60 new volunteers," stressed Mrs. Joan Lawrence in talking about C.A.R.D.'s (Community Association for Riding for the Disabled) move to new premises at the end of this month and its expanded program which will begin May 14.

C.A.R.D. is an organization dedicated to providing riding recreation, to stimulate muscular and mental coordination, for children and adults with disabilities. "Basically, we are looking for mature responsible people willing to give one morning a week of their time. It's not necessary that they be 'horsey' folk. As long as they are not afraid of a horse, we would provide the training."

The volunteers are required for leading or walking beside a horse on which a disabled rider is mounted or for helping at the mounting block where 4 assistants are required. A physiotherapist gives riders exercises while the horses are at the stand still or walk.

The organization is moving its headquarters to L'Amitie Stables, 5th line north of Gormley side road, where it has arranged for the use of a new arena and stable being built there. The sessions at their new home will be run on Saturday morning, 5

mornings a week and one evening, to accommodate more than 100 disabled children from C.N.I.B., Sunnyview School and Crippled Children's Centre. C.A.R.D. has also 24 adult participants, some stroke victims, in its riding program.
