**New Arena - need more ice**

MARKHAM - Councillors' backs shot up when they were told Markham should get out of the hockey business and let free enterprise get on with it.

Brian Lenard, one member of the Thornhill Church Hockey League delegation appearing before Council April 24, implied that the Town was proving incompetent in the organization of ice time for the new Markham Centennial Arena.

Fred Disera, league president, said if time could not be obtained at the new arena he would be faced with about 1,000 boys that wouldn't have facilities in which to play.

The league has been renting ice at Double Rink Arena "but we've now been told that we can't play there

any more." Mr. Disera explained that even if the league could stay, it would cost each boy \$75 for the season as opposed to the \$35 they pay now.

Councillor Bob Adams said the league had applied for 24 hours ice time at the Markham Centennial Arena but the arena committee could grant only 14.

"We need a minimum of 55 hours for the entire

league," urged Mr. Disera.

But it seems impossible. Mayor Tony Roman claimed that he wasn't the "good fairy" and could not wave his magic wand over night.

"For at least this year all hockey clubs in Markham are going to have to suffer to an extent and the problem of supplying ice time will

have to be resolved by the arena committee and council," explained Councillor Adams.

So back to the committee it goes for a report that will later be reviewed by council.

And in a final gesture, Councillor Adams wagered \$100 that a new community arena would be built in Thornhill before the 1974-75 season.
