## Declare profit

**UXBRIDGE TWP.** Revenue Properties Co., Toronto, developers of the now-defunct Century City project, has shown a profit for the year 1972 according to their latest unaudited financial report.

The company showed a net income of \$635,000 as compared with a net loss of \$2,282,000 in 1971. Revenue declined from \$28 million to \$22 million.

The earnings are equal to about 5.8c per share, and included a reversal of previously accrued deferred income taxes of about \$200,000.
