Teacher retires after twenty-eight years

GOODWOOD — Luella Tompkins, a native of Stouffville, is retiring after 28 years as a teacher and "I suggest to any teacher that the greatest thrill is to teach grade one pupils because you see more accomplishments in that year than in any other."

The retiring instructor has been in the teaching circles within the Uxbridge, Stouffville and Markham areas for the entire 28 years, spending the last four at Goodwood Public School.

"My first school was Union Secondary in Scott Township and later I spent five years at the Dickson Hill School in Markham," explained Mrs. Tompkins. She has taught for 21 years in Uxbridge Township.

But when asked if she objected, during an interview, to divulging her age, Mrs. Tompkins replied, "I certainly do mind! I'm not too young and not too old!"

Reminiscing back to her experiences, Mrs. Tompkins was almost stuck for one particular memorable moment. "When I was at Dickson Hill school, one of my eight year old pupils came to me one day and said he was in love with Dora. I asked him if he knew what it was like to be in love and he replied, 'no, but I think it's wonderful,'" chuckled Mrs. Tompkins, while remembering the moment.

But what about regrets? Mrs. Tompkins said she has only one during her entire career. "It's being conscious that you've failed a child, especially when teaching in rural schools because we didn't have access to consulting personnel and to a certain extent, the children suffered."

"But I can remember quite a few times," she went on, "having great success with a child, especially if you've really done something special for that child."

During her retirement, Mrs. Tompkins said she doesn't expect to do any supply teaching. "I think I'll just stay at my Roseville home with my family."
