

All Town or nothing at all argues Markham councillor

MARKHAM—Information Please, a community service operating out of the Markham Centennial Library aimed at informing new and old residents of services and businesses in the Town, should work for the entire Town of Markham, Councillor Gary Kay told a delegate last week.

Gail Newall, chairman of Information Please, appeared at the meeting to gain council's support to sponsor three pages in a handbook to be put out by the service.

The pages would include maps of Markham and Unionville at a cost of \$100 a page.

However, Council didn't seem that enthusiastic about spending the taxpayers' money for Town advertising.

Councillor Kay said he is all in favor of the service, "but what about serving Thornhill?"

The delegate explained that Thornhill telephone exchanges are long distance from Markham and Unionville and until Thornhill ex-

changes were made compatible with the rest of the Town, it wouldn't be feasible to serve the community.

"I don't think it's proper to spend public taxes on this kind of thing," commented

Councillor Harry Crisp. Information Please also serves the Souffville area.

Council neither accepted or rejected the request, but deferred a decision until its next meeting.

STOUFFVILLE—A rear-end collision at the Gormley Sideroad and the 5th Line Monday afternoon, sent a Souffville man to hospital and damaged two vehicles.

At the scene of the accident, rural mail carrier Helen Taylor, 57, of Edward Street, Souffville, said she was

turning left to continue her route up the 5th Line when her car was rammed by a pick-up truck. "I was waiting for a gravel truck to pass before I made the turn, when bang!" she commented.

A passenger in the car, Carl Watson of the 10th Line, Souffville, suffered minor head injuries and

was taken to York Central Hospital at Richmond Hill. He was released the same day. "Carl helps me deliver the mail," said Mrs. Taylor.

The driver of the pick-up truck, 39-year-old Bruce VanderBent of R.R. 1 Unionville, said he did not see any indication that the driver of the other car was turning.

"There was no way I could swerve out of the path of the car," commented Mr. VanderBent. A brigade from the Souffville Fire Department attended the call to water-down any spilled gasoline.

Neither party involved in the accident could offer any damage estimates.
