Your reference to the "inglorious" and "infamous" 12th Celebrations at Goodwood and Port

Perry, was an unfortunate attempt to insult and reduce the members of our Order, when in reality the parade is held as a commemoration of an ancient battle that was the historical turning point responsible for granting civil and religious liberty to the English speaking world. William III, whom you belittle as a "phony martyr" is indeed not venerated as such, by our members but is held in esteem for his inculcation of the British Bill of Rights which is accepted by the Canadian Government, and grants you freedom of speech to write this type of vitriolic report!

Next we received notice by mail that the owners of the west half of lot 13, con. 9, 100 acres, want permission to re-open the former Murray Ramer farm from the present rural to Zone M3 (for gravel operations.) This is across the road from us, part of Stouffville Ward 5. I believe. Why re-open gravel operations closed years ago and deface untouched land beside a main road (9th Line) to a tourist area? There is also a beautiful bush of mature trees there that should be preserved. Do we want the 9th to look like the 10th gravel areas? Talk about Uxbridge! Haven't we enough dirt, noise and scars in our area now?

I cannot understand council agreeing to this. Re-open the east half or even three-quarters butting on the existing pits on the 10th okay, but not the west half adjacent to the 9th con.

At this rate on lot 13, Merlyn will have his dump near, and we will have our gravel operations near. One consolation, if the hydro towers get both of us, they'll also get the gravel operators: Norma Tranmer, R.R. 2 Stouffville.
