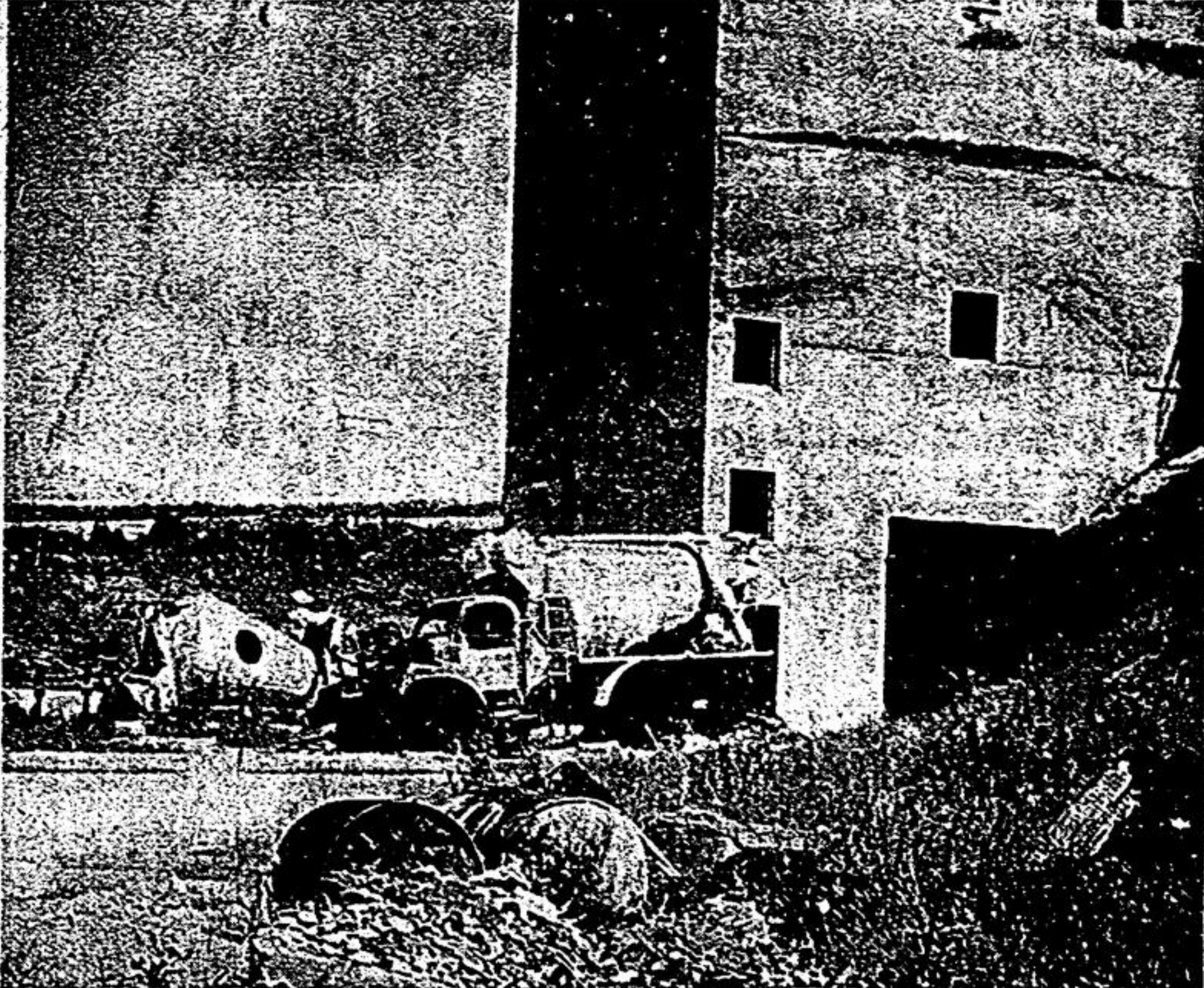
Mr. and Mrs. Douglas Gee, Ronald and Lois

ARE WE ABOUT TO FACE A FAMINE?

When shall these things be? and what shall be the sign of thy coming; and of the end of the world? MATTHEW 24:4, 5 "And Jesus answered and said unto them: Take heed that no man deceive you, for many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ, and deceive many and ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars; verse 8, All these are the beginning of sorrows."

The Lord is speaking of the signs preceding the time of great tribulation; that is, the pouring out of the wrath and judgment of God on this world. MATTHEW 24:21 "For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, nor ever shall be.

Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently; being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible; by the word of God, which liveth and abideth forever.

I Peter 2:24 — Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness; by whose stripes ye were healed. I Peter 3:18 — For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh; but quickened by the Spirit. I John 1:7 — The blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. I John 5:37, 5:41 — But he was wounded for our transgressions; he was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way; and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

He gave His life as a ransom for many. Mark 10:45. The value of Christ's sacrificial death is sufficient to redeem all mankind of every generation. If they will only repent, and believe in Him; accepting Him as their own personal Saviour. The righteousness of God, which is by faith of Jesus Christ, is unto all, and upon all them that believe. Romans 3:22.

The things that are happening now upon earth, wars, rumours of wars, famines, pestilences, earthquakes, the abounding lawlessness, moral degeneracy, are evidences of the closing moments of this day of grace.

The Lord Jesus will soon arise from His Father's throne and come to the air with a resurrecting, translating shout and all the redeemed of all ages will be resurrected, and living believers will be changed in a moment in the twinkling of an eye; to be caught up together with them in clouds to meet the Lord in the air. I Thessalonians 4:14 to 18 and I Corinthians 15:51,52 are full of comfort and rejoicing for the Christian. This will be the tribulation period of seven years, then Christ comes back right to the earth in bright glory, and splendour; He judges the nations of people living at that time; all Christ's rejectors of this present day of grace, and with the rejectors of the gospel of the Kingdom, and its messengers, all these will go into everlasting fire. Matthew 25:31-46. Christ will set up His Kingdom, and reign in righteousness, power, and glory for a thousand years. Satan and his close will be loosed, (Revelation 20:7) to head up man's final rebellion; fire comes down to consume them. The last judgment is carried out; the wicked cast into the lake of fire.
