

## Solve spree of thefts

STOUFFVILLE — An alert York Regional police constable checked out a car on the Ninth Line of Whitchurch-Stouffville, Monday, and later arrested six suspects on a series of charges.

P.C. Dennis Watts, a recent addition to the Force, observed a '69 model Barracuda parked crossways on the road, and a group of boys leaving the vehicle.

Three are charged with the break-in at the Stouffville Legion, July 30, and two face charges related to a break-in and theft at Musselman's Lake.

The accused are: Leo Fitzgerald, 17, of Musselman's Lake; Richard Sedore, 17, of Markham; Kurt Sooley, 16, Musselman's Lake; Paul Rennie, 16, Toronto, Stephen Jessome, 16, Stouffville; and Kenneth Michaud, 16, of St. Catharines.

The auto, police said, had been reported stolen from Niagara Falls.

In the break-in at the home of William Shultz, Valley Road, Musselman's Lake, a ring and other valuables were taken. The property was valued at \$1,506. The ring has been recovered.

## Release expected by Sept. 1

"The traffic and parking study which was conducted over the past few months in this village has been completed but delay has been experienced in receiving accident reports from police authorities. It is anticipated that the Study will be released by the first of September. It will include information on traffic counts, available parking places and traffic flow. It will make recommendations on traffic lights, pedestrian crossings and, in regard to parking, will define areas that could be used for this purpose. When the Study is received, the contents will be analysed by the business men in the downtown core who, in turn, will decide whether they are prepared to assume the financing for development of new parking areas. Recommendations made on the traffic flow would be followed up by the municipality."

Answer - The Public Works Committee will be proceeding with the installation of the hydrant in conjunction with Vern Davies, owner of Cedar Beach. It will be fed from a pump, placed underground, so that water will be available to firemen all year round. The hydrant will be a reality before the freeze up.

Question - With construction taking place within built-up areas in Stouffville, there have been complaints about the noise of machinery operating in the early hours of the morning. Can an anti-noise bylaw be instituted?
