Ringwood couple honored

RINGWOOD — Not too many people know that Ringwood was affectionately called "Slabtown" by the locals back at the beginning of the century; apparently from a pile of slabs left lying outside the home of John Moyer, a resident of the community at that time.

Mr. and Mrs. Edgar Brownsberger remember, for they have been "Slabtown" people all their married life — and that spans 50 years.

When Edgar and his bride-to-be, Pearl Gower, motored up to the Stouffville parsonage in a 1915 Touring Ford on their wedding day, August 15, 1923, they didn't have far to travel from their respective homes.

Pearl, one of five daughters of George and Mary Gower, lived across conc. 8 from Mr. and Mrs. Henry Brownsberger and their 2 sons and 2 daughters, near the Wideman Church.

Friendship blossomed into romance across the concession road and eventually led to matrimony when Pearl and Edgar were in their late teens.

The young couple, attended by the bride's sister Ada (Mrs. Fred Steckley) and the groom's brother, Mick, now of West Hill, were married by Rev. Edgar Morton of Ringwood Christian Church.

Appropriately, they settled near conc. 8 in a house, which they still occupy, south of Ringwood.

Their vista has changed considerably over the past fifty years. From their home, they recall, only two lights identified the Village of Stouffville after dark, in an era when horses and buggies travelled on the 8th were slowly losing ground to early model cars. At Ringwood corners was the old hotel (now a gas bar) once owned by William Button; across from it, on the east, Harry Spang's harness shop catered to the dwindling horse trade; the store on the north-east was operated by Mrs. Brownsberger's uncle, Joseph Grove; and Gran'ma Fockler, a venerable oldtimer, occupied the house on the north-west corner.

While the 8th (now Hwy. 48) is constantly changing, Pearl and Edgar Brownsberger's neat home, like their marriage, has remained constant to the passing scene.

August 15 marked the 50th plateau in their life together. The occasion was celebrated by all members of their family, relatives and friends.

Among the guests who attended an open house, hosted by daughter Hazel (Mrs. Bill Peacock) of Markham, Saturday, were: daughter Florence (Mrs. Herb Yakeley) of Stouffville; son, Bruce of Coeur d'Alene, Idaho; and 10 grandchildren.

Messages of congratulations were received from provincial and federal representatives, the Prime Minister and the Governor General.
