**Caravan serves communities**

Caravans, a program of voluntary service, sponsored by the United Church of Canada, works to serve communities across the country by starting such projects as coffee houses, drop-in centres, church camps, and sending youths to aid in senior citizens' homes. Headed by the Ontario Quebec Caravan committee are Bob and Beverly Thompson of Wilfred, a small community north of Pefferlaw, Mr. and Mrs. Thompson are formerly of Goodwood. "During a weekend recently, the couple of the committee hosted 10 volunteers at their home to hold evaluation meetings where each person judged the success of his or her project whether a coffee-house or a community recreation program. "We received \$900 in donations to operate caravans this summer with most of the funds in the form of grants from the United Church," explained Bob Thompson. Caravans began in Newfoundland in 1949 offering a summer vacation bible school which broadened into areas of baby-sitting services, children's recreational programs, tutoring and enrichment work. "This year we worked in the communities of Goodwood, Ballantrae, Sillome and Lemmonville," commented Mr. Thompson. Rev. Thompson, minister of Wilfred United Church, said Caravan volunteers must be over the ages of 16 years and are accepted, following application, in May.

Children's Choir The Stouffville Children's Choir is ready to resume practices on Sept. 13, at 7 p.m., in Stouffville United Church. All members are invited to return and any children wishing to join the choir are asked to come early, at 6:30 p.m. for audition. Children between the ages of 8 and 14 years are eligible for membership. The church, which opened in 1950, is of evangelical denomination. Members of its congregation are firm supporters of the missions and donated more than \$4,800 last year for this purpose. Evangel's Women's Missionary Society, as well as raising funds, organizes devotional programs and social functions. Music and participation by the congregation are an important part of the evangelical service. Although considered a neighborhood church, many of its members are not from the immediate area, but come from all parts of the Twin City.
