# M.P.P. wants Cedarwood clarified

Since the government of Canada and the Federal Department of Transport have called for a further study on the airport area, it has made it difficult for the Province of Ontario to make decisions. However, being very concerned about the residents who are living in the North Pickering Development Project area, I have been actively pursuing this matter with the Premier of this Province as I feel that the residents should not be kept in doubt any longer.

I have recommended to the Premier that an independent committee

of three, well-qualified people be set up, one from the area, and two other independent people, to listen to briefs from the residents of the area as to whether there should, or should not be, a North Pickering Development Project, to be completed within a maximum of three months.

I have also requested of the Premier that if it is planned to go ahead with this project, that the Hamlets of Whitevale, Cherrywood, Martin's Subdivision and Locust Hill be saved and that the people who live there and want to stay there, be given the right to remain.

I have also urged the Premier to have a large greenbelt surround the

North Pickering Development Project, especially on the west and southwest side, in order that we may have a large strip of open space between this Project and

Metro Toronto. I have also asked that serious consideration be given to cutting the size of this project if the airport is not built. I am still opposed to the airport as I feel it is not necessary.

## Faces 3 charges after break-in

STOUFFVILLE — John Charles Linther, 21, of RR 1 Stouffville faces three charges in connection with a break-in and theft at a Port Bolster residence.

According to a York Regional Police report, a house owned by Elston H. Taylor, of Port Bolster

was broken into sometime between Oct. 14 and 19 and articles stolen included a ring, shotgun and a rotor tiller. The items were valued at \$1,800.

Police searched the man's house and uncovered a carpet and shotgun, along with a

small quantity of marijuana. Linther is charged with break, enter and theft, possession of stolen property over \$200 and possession of a narcotic. He appeared in Provincial Court, Newmarket, but was remanded to Nov. 14.
