



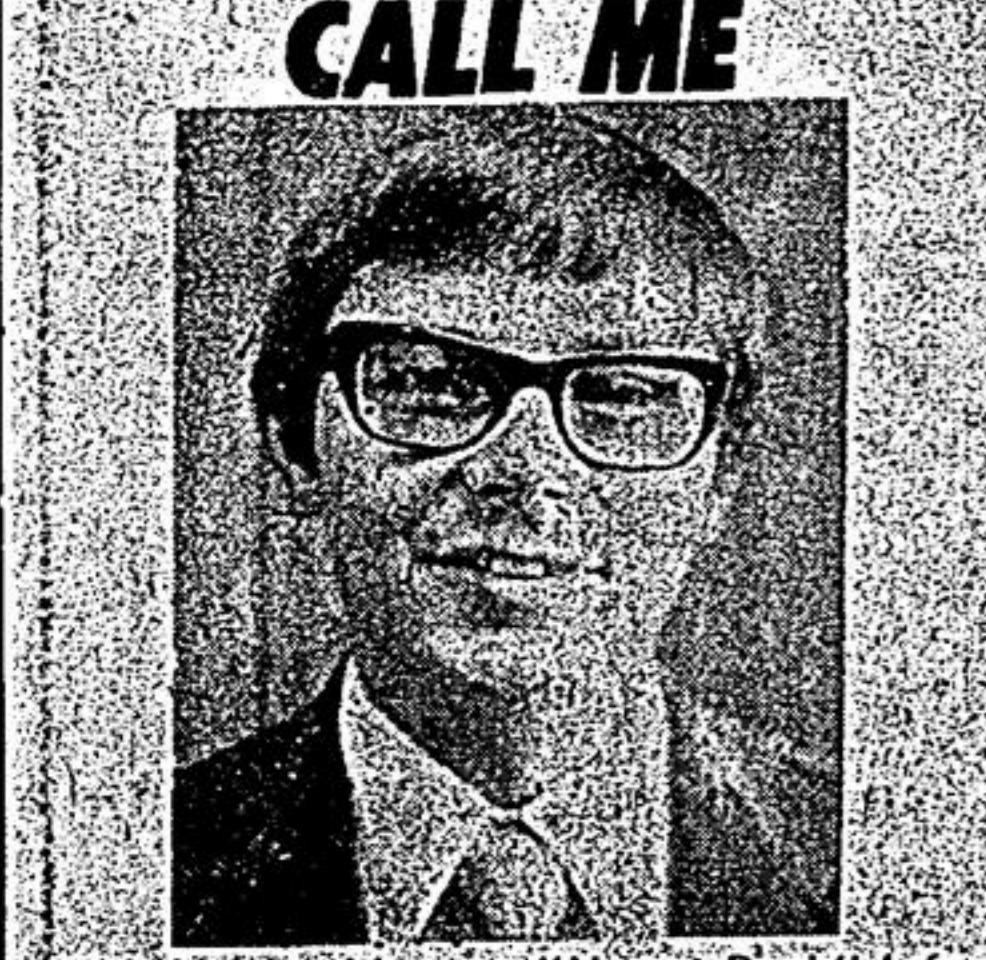
Chesebrough-Pond's presents \$100 Award

His mother, Raechel Lunau was born on the 5th concession of Markham. His great-grandfather, Joachim Lunau, was one of the first pioneer settlers in Markham Twp., arriving in the year 1794. His grandfather, Jonathan Lunau, and his wife, Matilda Forsythe farmed in Scott Twp. for many years.

Mr. Thompson attended school at Haggerman's Corners. His parents moved from there to Buttonville, then to Davenport Road and later to Zephyr where they farmed for several years. In 1916, Mr. Thompson married Margaret Jardine, in the home of authoress, L.M. Montgomery at Leaskdale. Mr. and Mrs. Thompson moved to Uxbridge in 1918, where he worked in Paxton's Grist Mill until it was destroyed by fire. He then helped Mr. Paxton build some of the first cottages at Musselman's Lake, after which he spent 36 years with the Uxbridge Creamery. He made his pick-ups by horse and sleigh in the winter and by truck in the summer. Mr. Thompson kept active, even in his later years. He took great pride in his garden, and would lend a helping hand to anyone in need. He also enjoyed sports and discussions about politics. The late Mr. Thompson leaves his wife, Margaret; three daughters, Helen (Mrs. J. Stiver), Uxbridge; Ruth (Mrs. H. Hamerston), Unionville; Irene (Mrs. J. Shorrocks), St. Catharines; eight grandchildren and seven great grandchildren. He is also survived by three sisters, Mary (Mrs. J. Cleland), Mt. Albert; Nettie (Mrs. J. B. Smith), New Toronto; and Iva (Mrs. Tim Forsythe), Toronto. Rev. Gibson of Uxbridge United Church officiated at the service, Oct. 26, from Lowe's Funeral Home, with interment in the family plot, North Glasgow Cemetery.

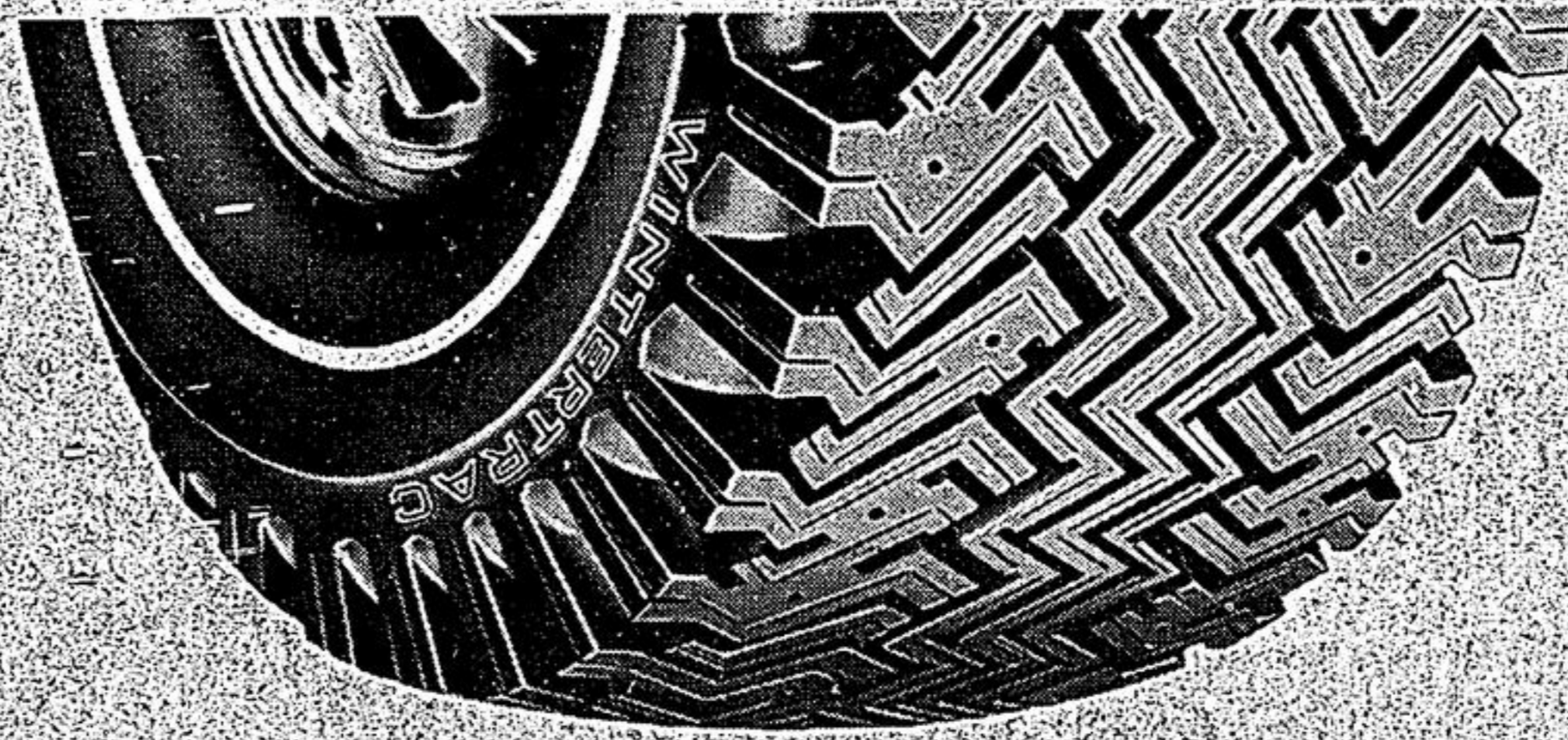

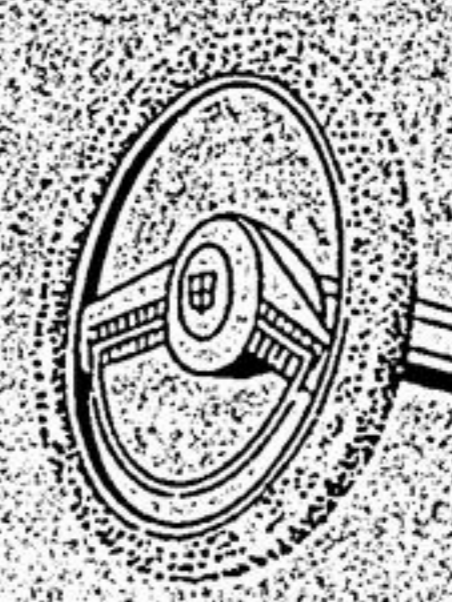
