POP alive and well

PICKERING — People or Planes is alive and well and living in Pickering Township.

That was the message that came loud and clear from a meeting of the group Nov. 26.

Efforts of the group are now toward persuading the Federal and provincial governments to cancel both the Pickering airport and the North Pickering Community Development.

The main reasons given for the opposition involved the waste of good farmland and energy resources which POP says will take place if the airport and the satellite city are built.

POP officials cited a study by two researchers from the University of Guelph indicating that the airport site includes some of the best farmland in Canada.

This rape of good farmland in southern Ontario for development has to have an effect on the supply and price of food, the group was told.

Lorne Almack, chairman of POP's technical committee, listed statistics that show how much fuel air travel requires compared to high speed rail vehicles.

He said that air travel requires one gallon of fuel to move a person 15 miles, while trains move a passenger 100 miles for one gallon of fuel.

Mr. Almack insisted that the present International Airport can meet Metro Toronto's needs.

Last week's meeting was a regular meeting of the POP executive but the organization has decided to convert these into public meetings periodically to give POP members and the public a chance to participate.

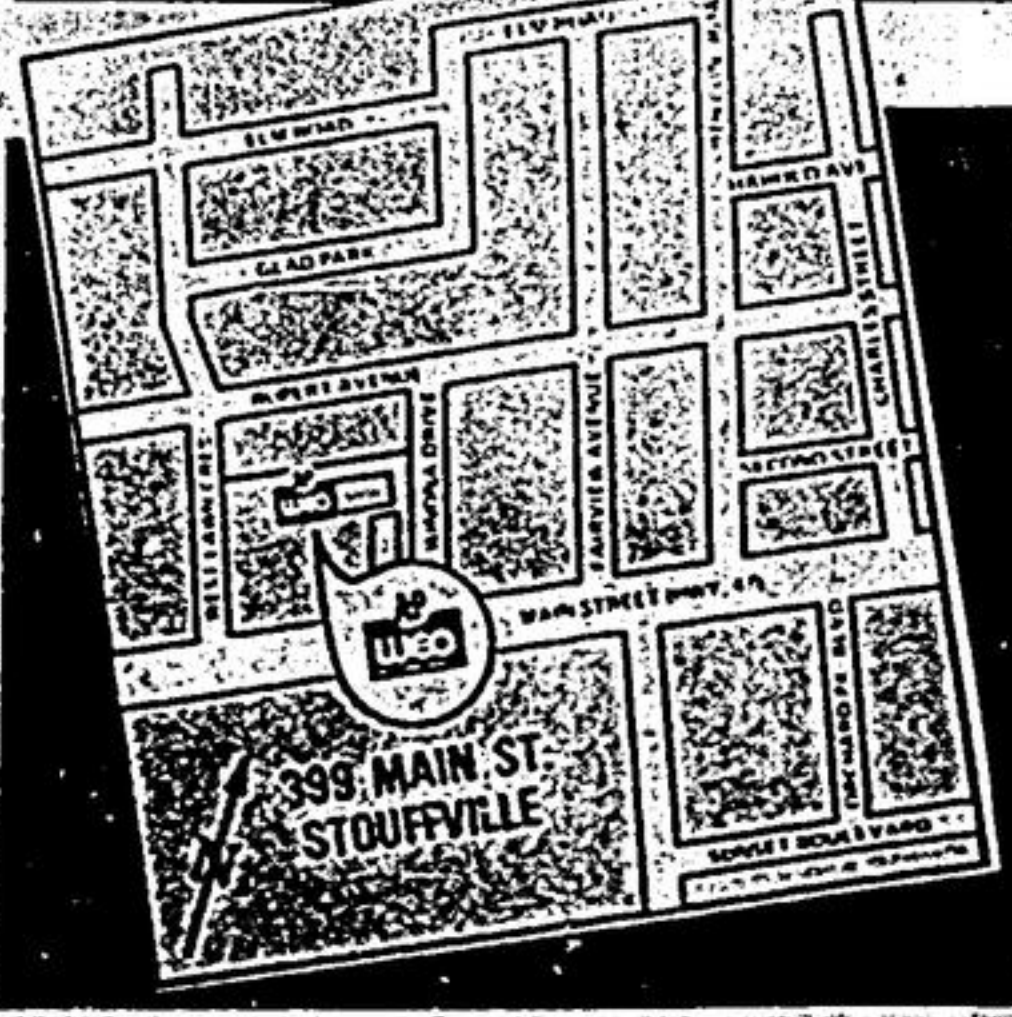
