**100-year-old store**

LEMONVILLE — The Lemonville Store, built over 100 years ago, is now a residence owned by Janet Williamson. But at one time the 7th

concession shop was the village meeting place for the local men to exchange views on happenings of the day.

The store, characteristic of those in days gone by with its cast iron stove in the centre, mounted on zinc to protect the wooden floor, is not too familiar to people now living in the area.

Mrs. James Clarke of R.R. 4, Stouffville recently compiled an account of the old store which she presented to the U.C.W. and The Tribune. The store at Pioneer Village is similar and the Lemonville store was probably something like it with its wide veranda. In earlier days commodities were bought in bulk and sold by weighing over the counter, explained Mrs. Clarke, probably one of the few residents in the area with knowledge of the building's past.

Her father-in-law, one of the shopkeepers at the Lemonville Store, according to Mrs. Clarke, used to tell the store of a young lad who, with a biscuit in hand, dipped into the molasses barrel "to sweeten the snack then PLOP!"

The indignant owner pulled him out and cried, "Dreep 'ye spalpeen, dreep."

Mrs. Clarke pointed out that some customers witnessing the "plunge" may have lost their appetite for molasses.

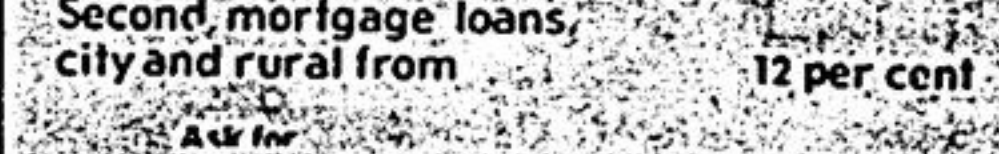
