Mrs. Harman, the former Flossie Irene Fockler, suffered a stroke, following 2½ months of illness.

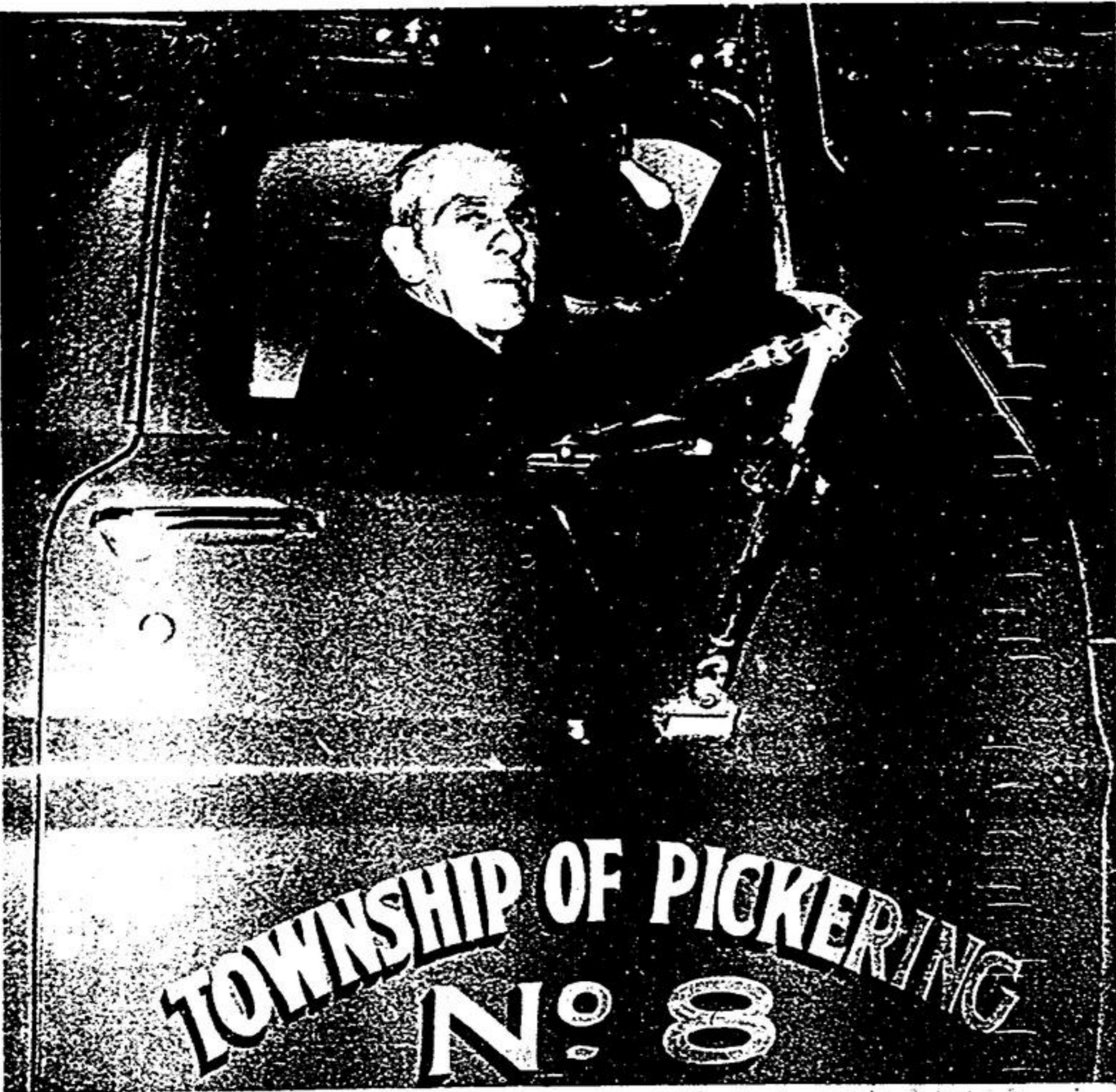
