Sinclair Stevens
Acclaimed PC candidate

YORK-SIMCOE — Four hundred and twenty-five Progressive Conservatives acclaimed Sinclair Stevens for their second time as their Candidate in York-Simcoe Riding, Wednesday, May 22.

Mr. Stevens, the standard bearer for the Progressive Conservatives in the 1972 election carried the riding handsomely with a 3800 vote majority. Judging from the response of his supporters, at the convention held in the new Aurora Legion, he's off to a running start in the current election campaign.

In his acceptance speech, Mr. Stevens said he hoped to be able to retain the riding of York-Simcoe for the Progressive Conservatives and that his party would form the next government in Canada.

To summarize what he called "Trudeau liberal economic incompetence," he pointed out that there has been 36

percent inflation in the past six years of Trudeau government rule. Unemployment had jumped from 315,000 people in 1967 to 520,000 last year — a two thirds rise. Unemployment Insurance benefits jumped in the same period from \$300 million to \$2.1 billion, a seven fold increase. Government spending has risen 139.6 percent from 1968 to 1974.

"Trudeau has spent or committed to spend more federal government money in his six years of office than all previous federal governments combined back to Confederation," Mr. Stevens said. "In 100 years federal governments in Ottawa spent less money than Trudeau has spent in six years," Mr. Stevens emphasized.

"It now costs \$10,000 a month to keep Trudeau in the style he has grown accustomed to. He has a \$76,000 limousine now and takes trips at public expense to far away lands such as the Barbadoes, the Swiss Alps and South

Sea Islands. Pearson got by on a fraction of that \$10,000 a month — he drove his own car and paid for whatever trips he wanted to take for his holidays," Mr. Stevens commented.

"As a top priority, a Progressive Conservative government would take step to curb inflation in this country. First, we intend to control government spending. The projected Turner Budget increase of 25 percent in federal expenditure this year is inexcusable," Mr. Stevens said. "We would not tolerate government spending at the federal level growing at over 20 percent per year as it has done under the present government." "Second," he said, "the money supply increases must be curtailed. The 60 percent increase in money since January, 1970 is like playing a game of Monopoly with the Canadian public."

"An incomes policy would help counter inflationary expectations

as well," Mr. Stevens said. "It would bring equity to the wage earner who has seen his real wages — his purchasing power — drop by \$2.50 per week in the last year alone". In addition, a Tory government would not hesitate to use a two price system if necessary to protect Canadian consumers against world price increases.

"A fifth point in the Conservative programme to curb inflation would be to limit the growth of credit in our country," he said.

"Inflation can be curbed, but it will take courage for any federal government to do it. A Progressive Conservative government will have that courage".

Mr. Stevens referred to the Stanfield team pointing out that it included former Prime Minister Diefenbaker, Provincial Premiers Duff Roblin and Mr. Stanfield himself, Deputy Prime Minister Paul Hellyer who was Trudeau's right

arm until he became disenchanted. Two justice ministers in Provincial Cabinets are now waiting to be active in a federal cabinet, Mr. Al Lawrence of Ontario and Mr. Claude Wagner of Quebec. In addition, we have former cabinet ministers such as Alvin Hamilton, Walter Dinsdale, George Hees, and Angus MacLean. Men like Eldon Wooliams and Jim McGrath would make excellent cabinet ministers as would many in the crop of 1972 he said.
