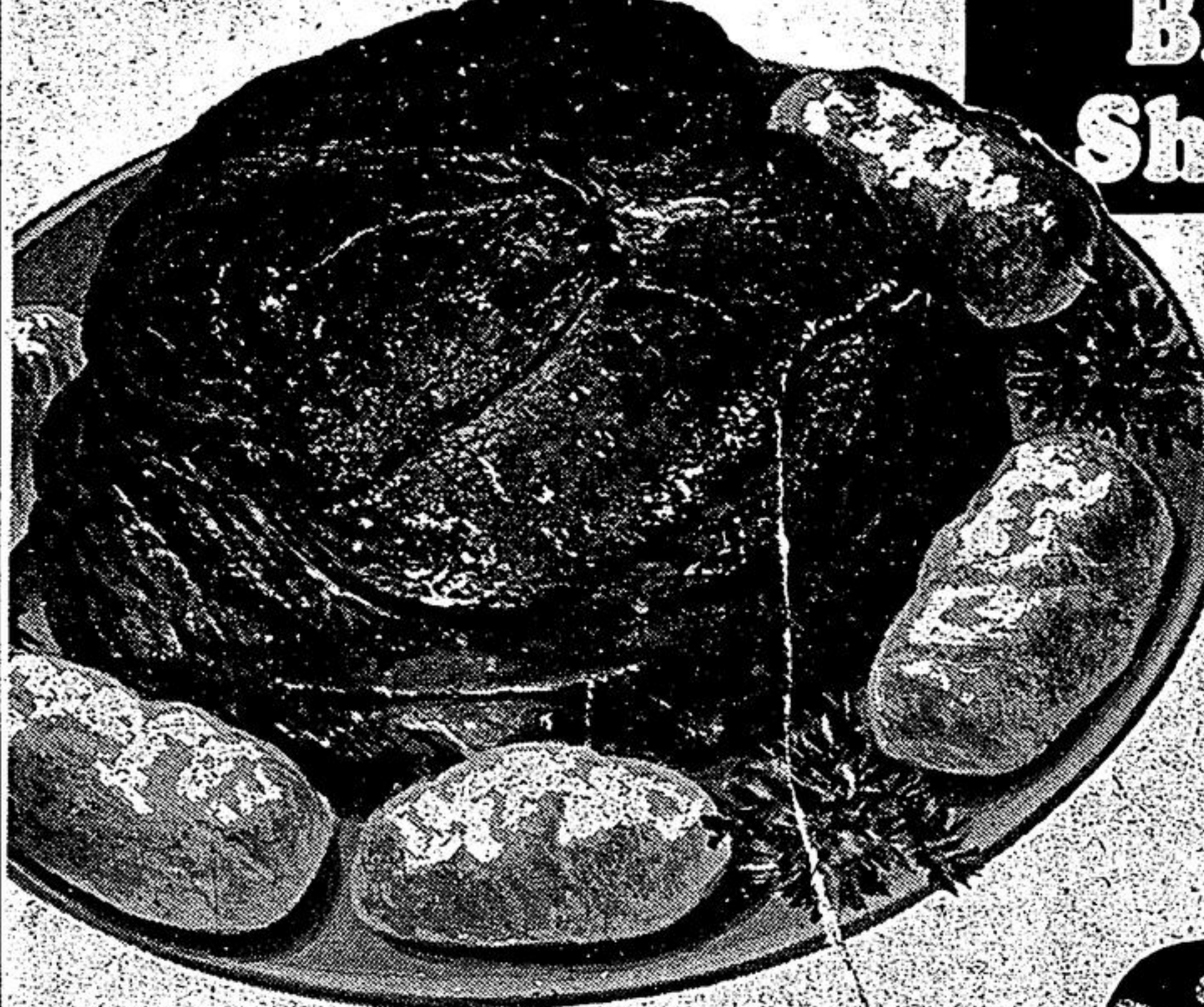
Graduate veterinarian
