**Plaza entrance presents problems**

STOUFFVILLE — The "entrance only" sign on Main Street at the Stouffville Plaza is being ignored by many motorists and represents a hazard to drivers who utilize both the right and left-hand lanes.

Mayor Gordon Ratcliff, when approached by The Tribune on the problem, readily admitted awareness to the danger, but said nothing had ever been written into the Plaza agreement to authorize proper exits and entrances to the site. He said he had received complaints and felt Council should take the matter up with the Plaza owner.

The mayor said the sign located there was not "legal", so charges would not stand up in court. He said the police were aware of this.

Mr. Ratcliff suggested that a close look was required throughout the Plaza area to solve the present traffic confusion there. He noted that one-way arrows had been utilized quite effectively elsewhere and could possibly be the answer in Stouffville.

**NOTICE RE LICENCING OF DOGS**

The Council for the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville has passed an amending by-law increasing dog licencing fees, as follows:

for a male dog if only one is kept	\$3.00
for the second male dog	10.00
for each additional male dog	15.00
for a female dog if only one is kept	5.00
for the second female dog	10.00
for each additional female dog	15.00

Where a certificate in writing by a Veterinary Surgeon or a receipt from a previous year is produced indicating that a female dog has been spayed, such female dog shall be taxed at the same rate as a male dog.
