**York planner**

**Major paper to be presented at convention**

NEWMARKET — York Region's Director of Traffic Engineering and Transportation Planning John Ireland will present a major session paper to a convention of leading North American transportation authorities in Montreal this month.

Mr. Ireland joined the Toronto and York Road Commission in 1965 as a Project and Design Engineer. He returned to the Commission in 1970 after two years at Waterloo obtaining his Master's degree. Mr. Ireland was appointed to his present position two years ago.

His subject will be "Feeder Bus Service for Access to Commuter Rail Service," a most appropriate subject in view of the planned coordination of bus service with proposed commuter rail service in The Region of York.

Professor John Shortreed of the University of Waterloo was a co-author of the paper which is based on Mr. Ireland's thesis written for his Master of Applied Science degree at the University in 1970.

"This is a significant honor to The Region of York," and our staff member, Regional Engineering Commissioner Robert Hodgson said today commenting on Mr. Ireland's forthcoming presentation. "It recognizes John Ireland's talent and ability, and certainly assures us in The Region of York that we have an extremely capable person responsible for transportation planning for our municipality."

**School levy down for 1974**

STOUFFVILLE — The York County Separate School Board levy is down an average of 1/2 mill, following passage of the board's 1974 budget.

The Total budget for the year is \$5,451,000, an increase of 19 per cent over 1973. Provincial grants have increased by the same percentage, while separate school assessment has increased 19 per cent.

This year the board will provide for 600 more pupil places throughout the region. The mill rate for separate school supporters in Whitchurch-Stouffville is 8.475 and for Markham, 7.862.
