Mayor Gordon Ratcliff Wants theatre first in proposed plaza

STOUFFVILLE Mayor Gordon Ratcliff commented Friday he disagrees with the plan of the developers of the proposed plaza at Hwy. 47 and Main St. E. to construct the theatre as a second stage of construction.

"I would like to see the theatre go in the first stage," the mayor explained. He feels the theatre is needed in the community and is the only business the developers are offering to put in which won't be a duplication of existing services.

According to the mayor, the developer has got to come in with a site plan and then get a rezoning before construction can begin. "I think I would agree to two stages with the theatre in the first stage."

Question: Now that the Regional Health Unit has issued a report favouring the old post office building as a day care centre what steps will be taken to implement this plan?

"Council will have to proceed on obtaining a price for the post office building from the government. A day care centre could be started almost immediately if we acquire the building."

Question: Will the Thicketwood subdivision now being constructed south of Main St. in the east end be completed in one stage or will it be a two part development?

"In the first stage 130 homes will be built and 50 will have to be held back until the next extension of the sewage plant. The second phase could go at the same time as the Divulverton subdivision, as the extension will be required at that time."

Uxbridge votes yes to liquor

UXBRIDGE - The whole of Uxbridge Township will have liquor lounges with food following the vote last week on two questions. All three former municipalities favored the change. The Township was previously dry.

The other question concerning liquor lounges without food was defeated in Scott and the town of Uxbridge, but supported in the former Uxbridge Township.

Only 1877 out of a possible 6,300 voters cast ballots in the plebiscite.

Markham factory will close doors

MARKHAM - Kent Tools Ltd. of Lairdway Blvd., Markham, will close its door at the end of September to relocate in a Tottenham plant.

The firm employs 90 people with only six slated to move with the company to Tottenham.

A spokesman for the company cited pure economics as the reason for the move. The company owns property in Tottenham and need larger quarters than provided at the Markham location.

The plant has been in Markham for 15 years and the move will mean a \$5,600 tax loss to the municipality.

Houseplant care Bring plants in to avoid frost

Bring in your houseplants in from the garden well before the frost can nip them, advises J.H. Hughes, Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food horticulturist.

Report the plants in containers one to two inches greater in diameter than the root balls. Prune them to compensate for the loss of foliage and to shape the plant so that "burning" both on houseplants and in the garden and on those newly purchased until you are certain they are free from pests, isolate all plants, especially African violets, if you do not, aphids and whiteflies may quickly infect all the home while spiders and scales can also cause trouble. When a new plant is severely injured it should be destroyed.

"Aerosol spray insecticides are available at most garden centers and are simple to use. Place a cardboard carton on its side, put the plant in it, and direct the mist into the carton. Hold the nozzle away from the plant so that "burning" will not occur. This method concentrates the spray on the plant and avoids contamination of the rest of the room.

Some houseplants can also be dipped in insecticides.
