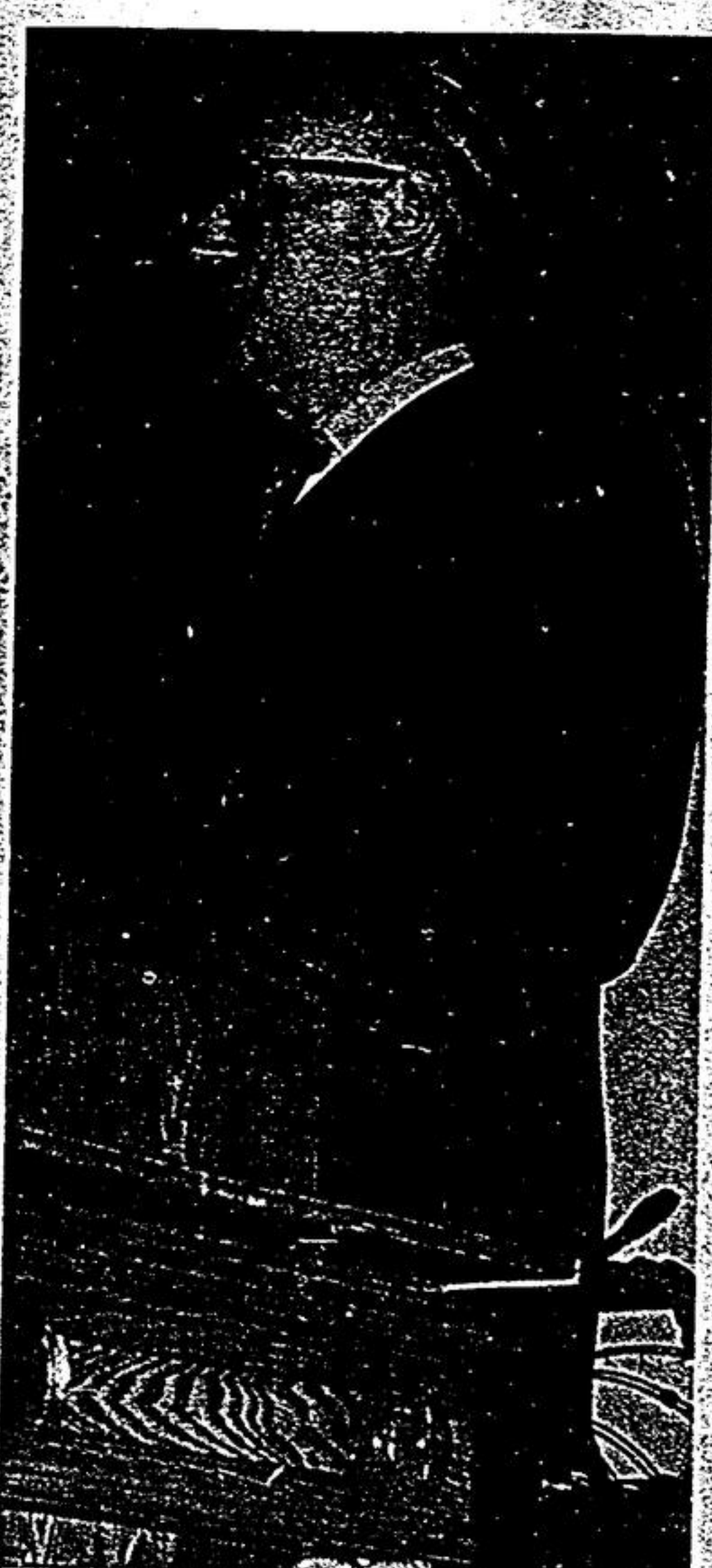


Sacred Music Night marks anniversary

Board approves new junior high school

RICHMOND HILL — York Region's Separate Catholic School system will extend to Grade 10, following a decision by the board Oct. 8. The trustees voted unanimously to extend Catholic education to Grade 10 by adopting a junior high school concept.

The commitment is to provide Grade 9 classes by September, 1975 and Grade 10 the following year. The first junior high school will be built in the southern part of the York Region, with one in the north, if demand warrants it.

A special committee has been studying the situation, after Catholic school supporters said they had trouble placing their children in Toronto Catholic high schools.

Eugene Jacobs told the board that despite lower provincial grants for Grade 9 and 10 in Catholic schools, that public schools, the board would be able to absorb the extra cost, by efficient financing and good programming.
