**BUTTONVILLE.** — The Town of Markham has received a \$300,000 Federal government loan for the construction of an addition to the municipal offices on Don Mills Rd.

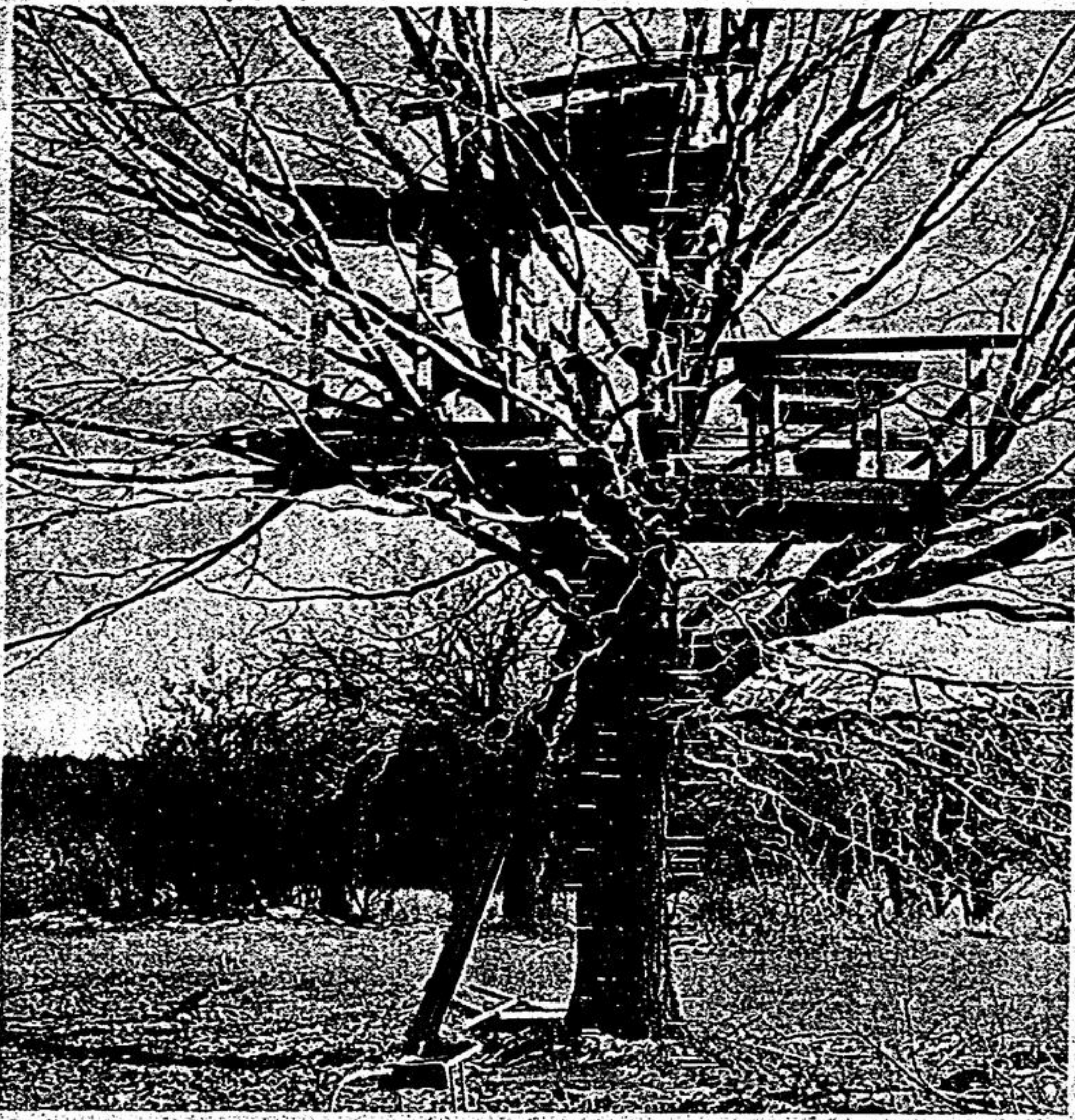
Mayor Tony Roman and Urban Affairs Minister Barney Danson announced the loan.

Work was started on the addition in September and according to Mr. Roman, "will decidedly have a beneficial affect on the present unemployment problem."

The mayor added that the municipality would like to centralize its administration. Presently, the town is renting office space outside for the planning, engineering and building inspection departments.

The new building will ease some of the problems involving communication and public inconvenience.

"It is essentially sound judgment to gather our forces into one unified location," the mayor said.
