## Over 400 attend Slack auction

STOUFFVILLE — Over 400 people attended the auction sale of the belongings of Henry Slack, Saturday behind the Slack residence on Main St. E.

While the prices were not as high as some sales, the volume of goods kept auctioneers Walter Atkinson and Lloyd Wilson working simultaneously from 12 noon to 6 p.m.

Top price for the day went for a Victrola in working condition. It sold for \$190. Some 78 r.p.m. records to play on it sold for \$20.

Other top items included — round dining room table, \$180; hall rack, \$115; marble-top stand, \$110; chest of drawers, \$60; pine box, \$100; and two vases and a China clock, \$155.

As well as furniture, there was a large assortment of garden and workshop tools and a large quantity of china wear.
