### Wife of former MLA dies at 91

Minnie Vivian "Bernie" Baker died of natural causes at North York General Hospital, Thursday, Aug. 7.

Mrs. Baker, who had been in failing health for some time, was predeceased in 1973 by her husband Morgan Baker, prominent Whitechurch farmer. Mr. Baker served as Whitechurch Reeve for seven years. Member of the Legislative Assembly for nine years (1934-43), and after his retirement worked as a real estate agent.

She was predeceased by her parents: Mr. and Mrs. Jos. Burnett, all her immediate family, and her son Robert Vowell.

In 1941 she married Mr. Baker and they lived for 29 years in King Township and she lived Wynford Heights Cres., Don Mills, for five years before her death. She was affiliated with the Anglican Church and was in her 92nd year at the time of her demise.

She is survived by step-children: Alma (Mrs. James Oldham), Doris (Mrs. Floyd Ratcliffe), Mary (Mrs. Keith Hutchinson) and Merlyn Baker, all of Stouffville and Alan Baker of Brussels, Belgium. She is aunt of John, Tessie, and Robert Murray of Vancouver.

Funeral services were conducted by Rev. W. S. Whitcombe, Saturday afternoon at Ogden Funeral Home, Sheppard Ave., Agincourt.

Interment was at Mount Pleasant Cemetery.
