BRONWYN PRECIOUS CLARK, A.R.A.D. — Mrs. Clark began her training in Toronto with Miss Lucille McClure with whom she did extensive lecture demonstration tours across Ontario as advance publicity for the National Ballet Company. In 1950 when the National Ballet School opened she attended for 3½ years as a full time scholarship student. She moved to Chicago in 1963 where she studied with Robert Lunnion and Doreen Tempest of the Royal Ballet of London, England. For 2½ years, Mrs. Clark was a member of the Allegro American Ballet Company with whom she toured the U.S.A. She returned to Toronto and has for the past seven years taught for Miss Gladys Forrester and Miss Janet Baldwin. Mrs. Clark is a member of the Royal Academy of Dance, having passed the Elementary, Intermediate and Advanced examinations, an Associate Member of the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing, Classical Ballet Branch, Cecchetti Method, has two C.D.T.A. Certificates for Tap, and was on full scholarship at the Banff School of Fine Arts for two years as well as on the staff of the Wardrobe Department. She has taught at Tam O'Shanter, the Hyland Ice Skating Centre, and the Oshawa Skating Club for several summers coaching champion figure skaters and for the past season

taught, with her husband, for the Recreation Department of Owen Sound.

WILLIAM CLARK — Mr. Clark has had extensive training in both Highland and Ballet with Miss Gladys Forrester in Toronto. He has passed his Associates and Membership Examinations with the Scottish Dance Teachers' Scotland, and many medal tests with the British Association of Teachers of Dancing, Scotland, and has won numerous medals and trophies in Competitions in Canada, and the U.S.A. He is also a Student Member of the Royal Academy of Dance, London, England and has studied on full scholarship at the Lakeview Summer School of Ballet, Elliot Lake Centre for Continuing Education and the Banff School of Fine Arts under many distinguished teachers including Arnold Spohr, Royal Winnipeg Ballet Company, Vera Volkova, Royal Danish Ballet, Elsbeth Strathern, Scotland, and James L. MacKenzie, Scotland. Mr. Clark has appeared in a number of stage shows at O'Keefe Centre, Royal Alexandra Theatre and Massey Hall; these include Brigadoon, as well as several reviews with Tom Kneebone and programs for Educational T.V. He has taught in Toronto, Owen Sound and Oshawa within the past several years.
