The first year of operation saw the Panthers make the play-offs which is a great accomplishment for a first year club.

Two years ago saw the Panthers go all the way to finish the regular season in first place as League Champions for which we won the Gary Archer Memorial Trophy. Losing only 6 games in the 44 game schedule, the Panthers were 3 points away from tying a record for most points in one season.
