Whitchurch native passes away

STOUFFVILLE — Mrs. Lorna Gilbert passed away at Toronto Western Hospital. She was a native of Whitchurch Township, having been born on Oct. 4, 1912.

She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Albert Hoover, and spent all her life in the Stouffville area. She married Stanley

Gilbert on Aug. 4, 1928. Mr. Gilbert predeceased his wife.

Mrs. Gilbert was a member of Bethel Assembly of God in Ringwood, and had attended there for two years. She leaves behind one daughter (Mrs. John White) of Newmarket and

two sisters, Ruth (Mrs. Wright) of Newmarket and Leona (Mrs. Howard Rosenbarker) of Whitchurch-Stouffville and three brothers, Ernest and Walter of this area and Edward of Claremont. She had one grandchild, John White Jr.

Funeral service was

held from O'Neill's Funeral Home and was conducted by Rev. Howard Minaker. Pallbearers were Jack Morgan, Gordon Forsyth, Paul Marshall, Wellington Yake and two nephews, Albert and Allan Gilbert. Interment was Lemonville Cemetery.

GREENWOOD — A large 19th century walnut bookcase sold for \$2,250 at auction sale of the estate of the late Edna Green, Saturday, at the community centre here.

Miss Green's death marked the end of an era for the hamlet. She was the last surviving member of the Green family after which the hamlet was named.

Many items in the sale were 19th century pieces. Miss Green died in October at the age of 67.

Frederick Green, a miller from England, purchased a mill on Duffins Creek in 1843. He became known as Squire Green and became a large property holder in the area.

The top selling item in the sale was carved a

century ago by prisoners at Kingston Penitentiary. A rosewood spinette desk sold for \$300.

The sale featured other pieces of 19th century furniture, furs and boxes, as well as boxes of china with names such as Limoges, Royal Doulton, Wedgwood and Staffordshire.

Other valuable items, some owned or made by John A. Macdonald or King Edward VII when he was Prince of Wales, were disposed of as part of Miss Green's bequests.

Miss Green's house, built 18 years ago on the foundation of a century-old home, has been sold.

Despite the cool weather, there was a good turnout for Saturday's sale.

Linda Eastwood of Port Perry called on the Brown family, Salem Road on Sunday.


The November meeting of the Senior Citizens was held in the Whetstone United Church on Tuesday afternoon Nov. 25.






