(Key of G)

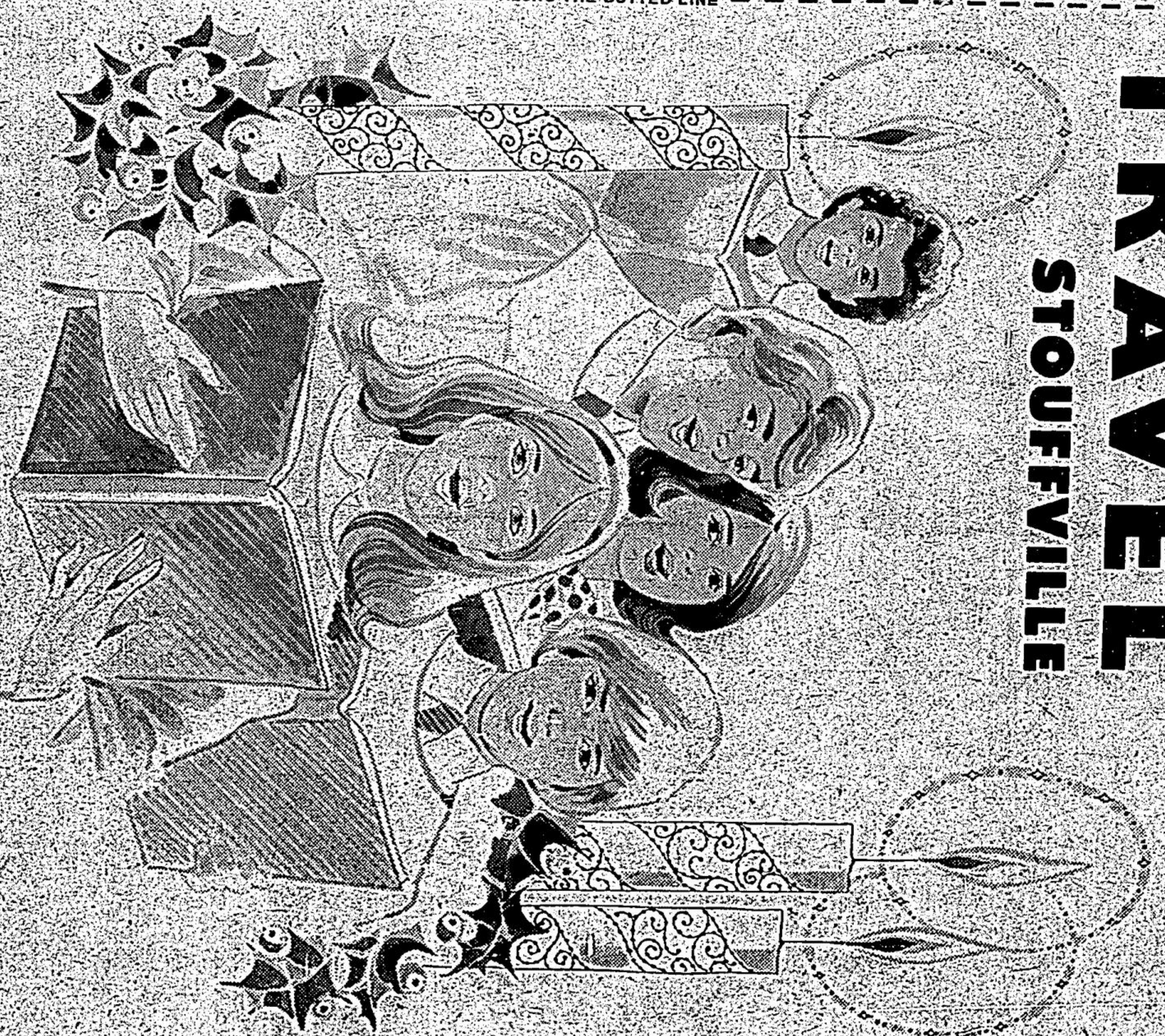
O little town of Bethlehem!
