

Farm Report**Reduction program claims must be in**

The Farm Tax Reduction Program is being finished up now, for 1975. These payments by the provincial government are made so that farm owners will pay only their equitable share of the municipal tax load. Without the program,

a farm with assessment on the house, farm buildings, plus a large acreage of land, would end up paying two or three times as much tax as other rural residents.

The claim for the 1975 refund has to be in by Dec. 31. To be eligible, the property must be assessed as a farm and have at least \$200 in sales of farm products.

Producing dairy cattle by the embryo transfer method has come to York in a big way. At the open house for Via Pax at Woodbridge last week, we saw forty or fifty donor cows and around 400 recipients at various stages in the process, as well as very modern facilities.
