

# Police tower ready

**NEWMARKET** — York Regional Police Chief Bruce Crawford last week reported to the Regional Police Commission that a new communications tower which will cover the southern portion of York Region, is now ready to go into action.

The Chief told the Board the tower is now completed, a hook up was expected last Tuesday.

The tower located on a one acre piece of land at the Centennial Park in King Township on the site, concession will cost the Regional Police Force \$1 for a 10 year lease.

Judge William Lyons, Chairman of the Board said last week, the Regional Police Commission is grateful to King Township Council for permitting the construction of the new tower on Township property.

The one acre area will be fenced and screened by Lombardy poplars in accordance with the wishes of King Township Council.

# District replaces divisions

**NEWMARKET** — The York Regional Police Commission last week approved a recommendation from Regional Police Chief Bruce Crawford for the adoption of a new organizational chart.

The Chief said the new charting has become necessary because of the relocation of the southern police divisions into the one building at Richmond Hill.

Number 27, 28 and 29 Divisions are now eliminated and will now be known as No. 2 District. Re-allocation of duty inspectors will be made, and Chief Crawford told the Board the Force will have sufficient sergeants to work all shifts on a 7 day a week basis.

# Farm stability forecast for coming year

Stability is probably the best feature in the farm forecast for 1976. Prices for milk, dairy products, beef, poultry and feed grains are expected to just hold their own, with the only real problem being hogs in the last half of the year.

There has been some optimism that beef markets would get better fairly soon. Beef calves, veal, cows and low grade slaughter cattle have been losers for quite a stretch, and margins over feed cost on even good slaughter cattle have been quite narrow.


The beef analysis still indicates that beef numbers won't start down until half way through 1976, and even then supplies will be heavy because cattle are being fed to heavier weights now. A good point is that we are eating more beef per person, about 100 lbs. forecast for this year, compared to around 95 lbs. in 1974.

We can hope of course, that the ever increasing costs for inputs like fuel, machinery, fertilizer, pesticides, and labour will level off, with the new price controls. Some of the main ones however, will not be affected. Imported machinery, fuel, phosphate fertilizer, and some feed ingredients will likely still go up, being outside the control program.

So it looks like a situation of prices staying about where they are, with the danger of costs going up. The only control a farmer has is to cut his own costs, in every way possible.


A good set of farm-kept records could help. With the records right at home, the big costs can be spotted quickly. We have new account books this year, that follow a good system for cost control as well as income, tax, and they are still free.

Rebates on the federal excise tax of 10 cents per gallon on gas used in farming, can be claimed now.
