

Annual farm show set for Jan. 27

Farm equipment displays by 250 exhibitors will be combined with a lively program of tractor and horse pulling events at the Canada Farm Show, January 27 to 30 at the Coliseum, Exhibition Place, Toronto.

"The 1976 show will be the largest we have ever held," said Dawn Morris, show manager. "All available exhibit space in the Coliseum's Industry Building has been taken and we have had to expand the show into the Coliseum's north extension."

Mrs. Morris said that exhibits will occupy more than 160,000 square feet of space. "Exhibitors now booked into the show represent about 600 manufacturers, including most of the major tractor manufacturers," she said.

Sponsored by the Ontario Retail Farm Equipment Dealers Association, the annual show is Canada's largest indoor agricultural equipment exhibition which last January drew attendance of 52,605 people, mainly from rural Ontario. Attendance included 45,109 farmers and their families, as well as farm equipment manufacturers and dealers, agricultural students and special guests.

The big farm equipment displays will be seen in conjunction with a featured program of tractor pulling and horse-drawn events, a draft horse sale, daily attendance prizes and a farm film festival showing latest agricultural techniques.

Sponsored by the Ontario Belgian Horse Association, championship draft horse draws for purses totalling \$4,000 will be held on the show's first two evenings, Tuesday and Wednesday, January 27 and 28. Light and heavy horse draws will each award \$2,000 in prize money.

Also sponsored by the Ontario Belgian Horse Association, a championship draft horse sale will be held at the show on Thursday, January 29. The sale will include about 100 head of Registered and Grade Belgian, Clydesdale, Percheron and Commercial horses as well as a variety of horse equipment.

Canada's only indoor tractor-pull for purses totalling \$10,000 will be held on the show's last two nights, Thursday and Friday, January 29 and 30. Sanctioned by the Canadian Tractor Pullers Association, six events for modified and super stock tractors will each award \$1500 in purses to winning pullers.

In addition, two events for mini-tractors sanctioned by the Canadian Mini-Tractor Pullers Association will each offer \$500 purses.
