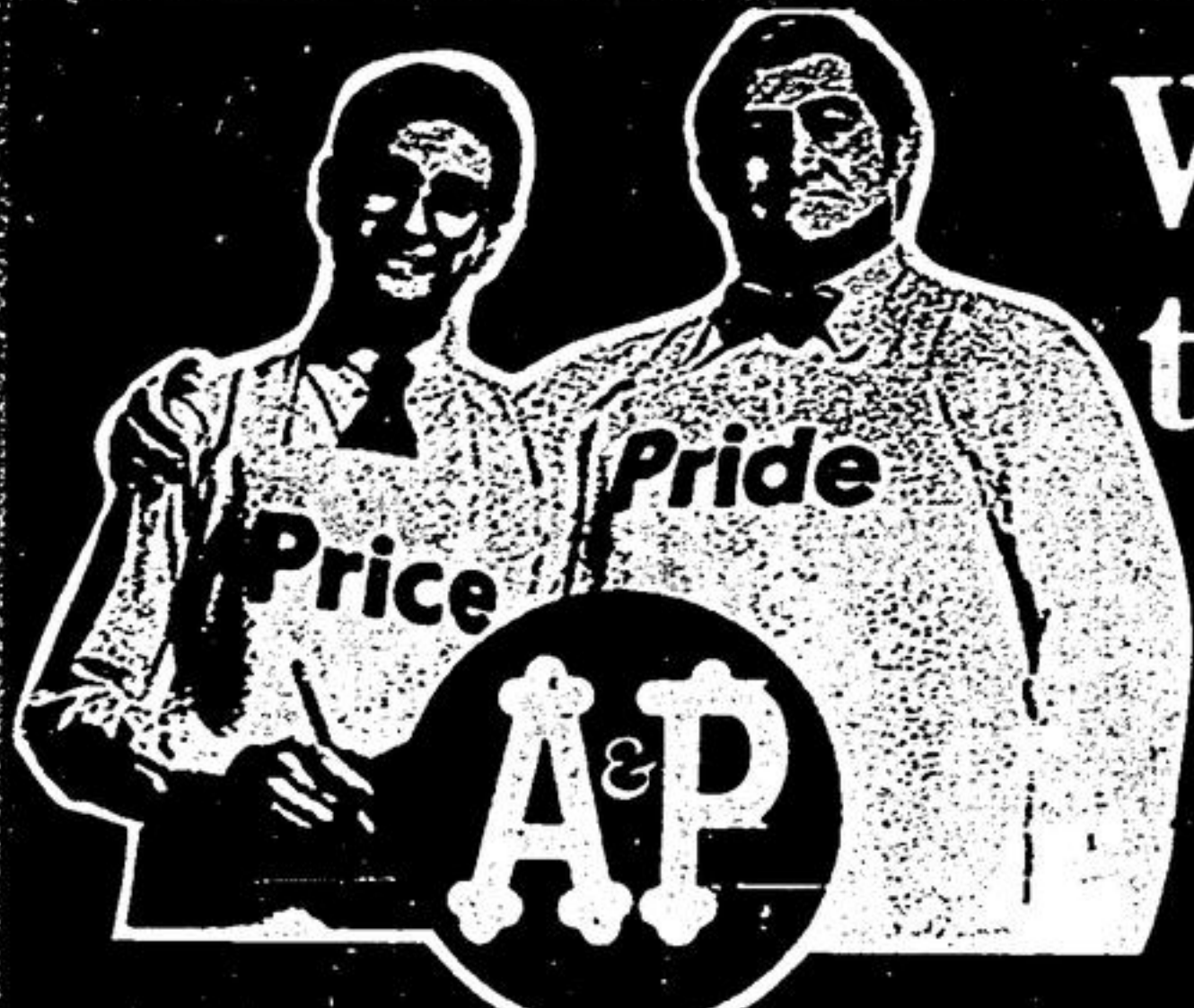

Officers elected at meeting

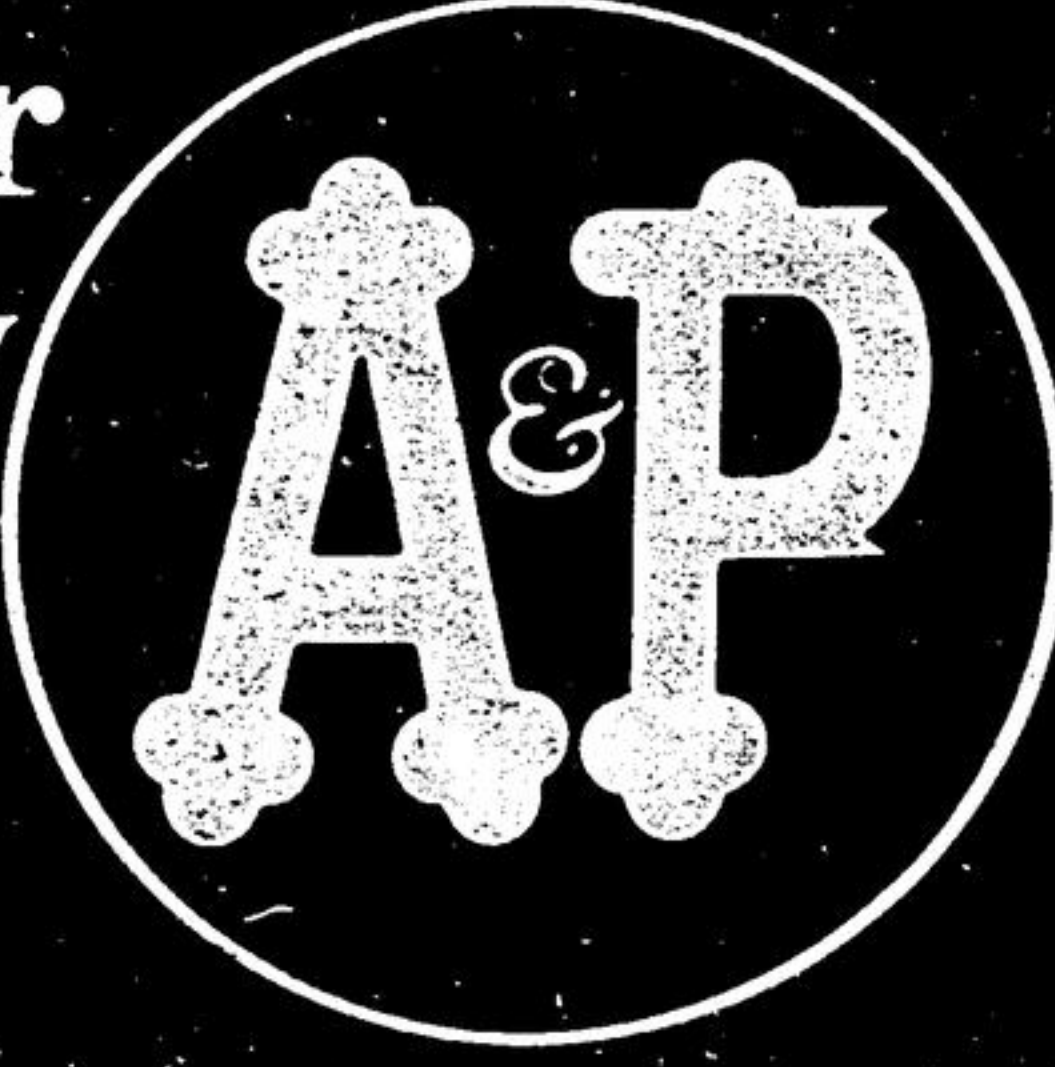
