Public meetings as noted above will be held by the Planning Committee of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville to present the proposed new Official Plan to the public. The new Official Plan has not been adopted by the Planning Committee or Council and the purpose of these meetings is to obtain comments, suggestions and opinions from the public including objections to or support of the Plan.
The Planning Committee invites you to attend these meetings. If you are unable to attend, written submissions will be received up to November 1st, 1976.
The complete text of the Official Plan will be available for study at the Municipal Offices, 19 Civic Avenue, Stouffville during regular business hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) and may also be purchased. A free brochure summarizing and highlighting the Official Plan will be available on request at the Municipal Offices. (Please note that the complete text and brochure will not be available until Wednesday, October 13th, 1976.)
NOTE: The October 20th, 1976 public meeting to be held at Ballantrae will also be used for the purpose of obtaining public response to proposed Amendment No. 14 to the Official Plan of the Whitchurch Planning Area (the BALLANTRAE-MUSSELMAN'S LAKE SECONDARY PLAN). The Secondary Plan may be examined at the Municipal Offices during regular business hours. (The final draft of Amendment No. 14 to the Official Plan will not be available until Wednesday, October 13th, 1976.)
