Durham Region picks commissioner

A new chief administrative officer for Durham Region was chosen last week. Regional works commissioner Bob Richardson was approved by council by a 17-11 vote in a closed-door session. He replaces retiring Bill Manning.

The cost of having a consultant involved in the selection of a new officer, according to management committee chairman Alan Dewar, will be about \$8-9,000.

Lost revenue Federal MP for Ontario riding, Norm Cafik, said last week he is pushing to have the federal government pay the Town of Pickering some \$200,000 in back taxes owed by tenants on lands expropriated for the proposed Pickering airport.

Mr. Cafik said that the federal government should then collect the taxes from the tenants themselves.

The Town of Pickering has no authority to collect taxes on Crown-owned land and some of the tenants either are transients or have refused to pay the taxes.

Hydro rollback Pickering executive committee wants the Ontario cabinet to either stagger or roll back the 30.3 per cent increase in Ontario Hydro bulk power rates for 1977. Councillor Jack Anderson said the average consumer is restricted by the Anti-Inflation Board guidelines and suggested that Hydro should be governed by the same guidelines.

Welfare below budget The Durham Region welfare budget may end up \$800,000 below budget the end of this year. According to a report presented last week to the regional social services committee, a projection of this year's budget based on expenditures for the first nine months may be \$797,842 below the budget allocation. The projected spending total would be \$4,804,776.
