Minor hockey message

To mark Minor Hockey Week, January 22-29, the Ontario Hockey Association will place posters in rinks all over Canada. The poster has a picture of a young player looking up at the coach and saying, "Thanks Coach". The poster very effectively conveys the theme of thanking the volunteers in hockey, and is a well-aimed message.

BUT the message from Ron Smith, who is Hockey Technical Director for Ontario, coach of the Guelph Junior A Platers, (1976 O.H.A. champions) and Chairman of the Coaching and Cer-

tification Committee of the Ontario Hockey Council is more specific! He says, "Let's not thank coaches who don't try to improve their technical knowledge, teaching skills and coaching philosophies, who yell at their players, who yell at referees, who play their 'stars' all the time, and who believe that winning comes before everything else", and suggests ways of helping these kinds of coaches.

The Coaching and Certification Committee of the Ontario Hockey Council recommends, for the sake of the players, that local community

hockey associations do three things:
1. have all their coaches attend National Coaches' Certification Program clinics as often as possible,
2. have regular coaches' meetings where ideas can be exchanged and special guests, films and panel discussions can be used to help the coaches improve,
3. form a "Coaching Committee" to monitor and evaluate all coaches often.

The coach is the most important influence on a hockey player and we owe it to the kids to see that he does a good job. THE GAME IS FOR THEM AND WE MUST DO EVERYTHING TO HELP THEM ENJOY THE GAME.

STOUFFVILLE — On Saturday Jan. 15, the Stouffville Bantam A's travelled to Markham to play the league's top team in the final game of the year.

In previous games the Don Anderson team had been shut out 6-0 and 5-0 by Markham, but not this time!

The game started out very fast with plenty of good scoring chances at either end, and only stand out goalending by Stouffville's Mark Forrester and Markham's Mark Cooper kept the first period scoreless.

Early in the second period Steve Easey rapped in a rebound to give Markham a 1-0 lead. Tony Leger evened the score with a beautiful solo effort at the 45 second mark in the third period.

But only 23 seconds later Markham caught the Stouffville team napping and pulled ahead 2-1.

Stouffville's penalty killing duo of Dave McKenzie and Dave Raymer, which nullified the potent Markham power play all evening, produced the tying goal late in the third. Raymer stole the puck from a Markham defenceman at the blue line, raced in alone, and ripped a quick shot into the net.
