## Godfrey replies to Housing Minister

Dear Sir:

The recent reply by the Honourable John Rhodes to my statements have attempted to gloss over the basic economics of the North Pickering Development.

The Government of Ontario spent \$200,000,000 in acquiring land for the North Pickering Development. It has spent many more hundreds of thousands of dollars in maintenance and "planning" for the new development. The carrying charges alone over a five year period, since acquisition began, should average \$20,000,000 per year.

Maxwell Henderson, in his recommendations to the Government of Ontario, said the Government should get out of the landbanking business. He graphically pointed out the expense associated with such ventures.

The North Pickering Project is not needed. There is ample land for residential and industrial expansion in the southern part of the riding.

But most importantly there is urgent need for those millions of dollars which have been (and will be) spent before we see One New Dwelling!
