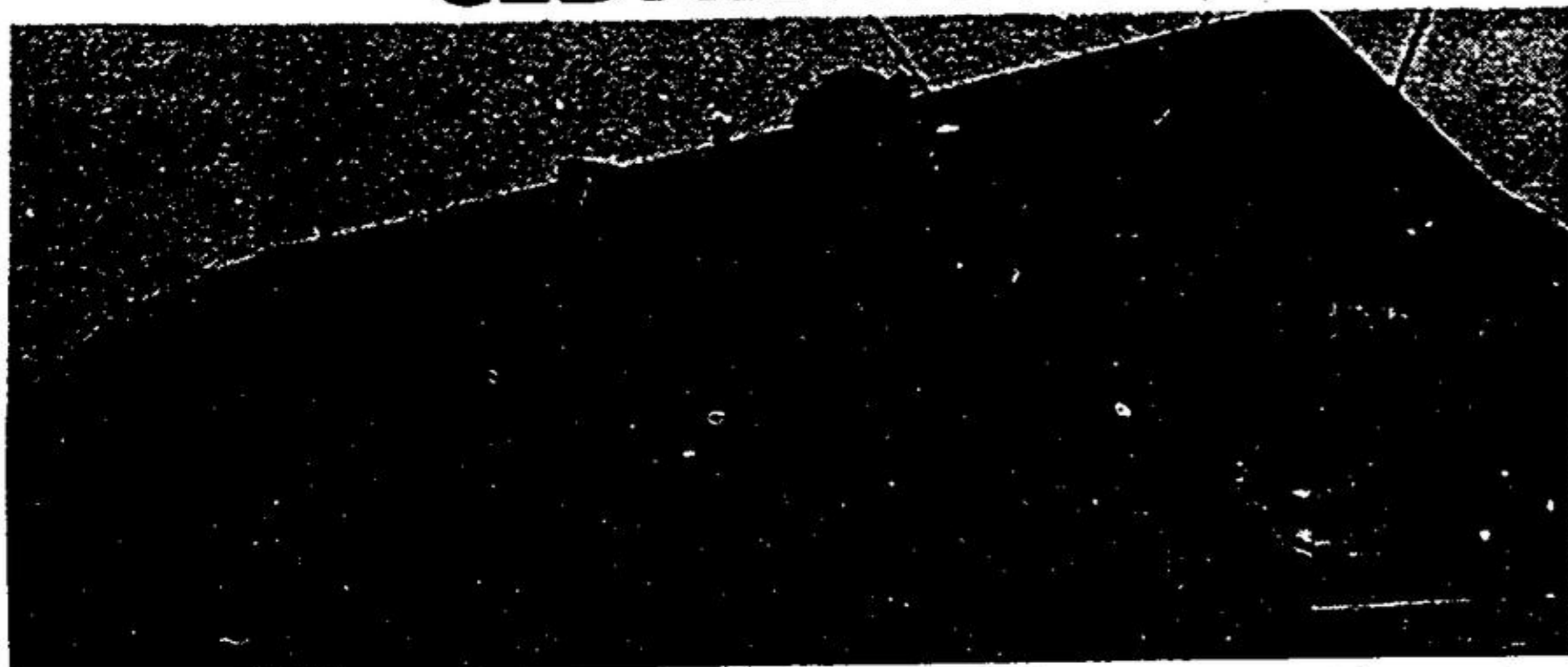

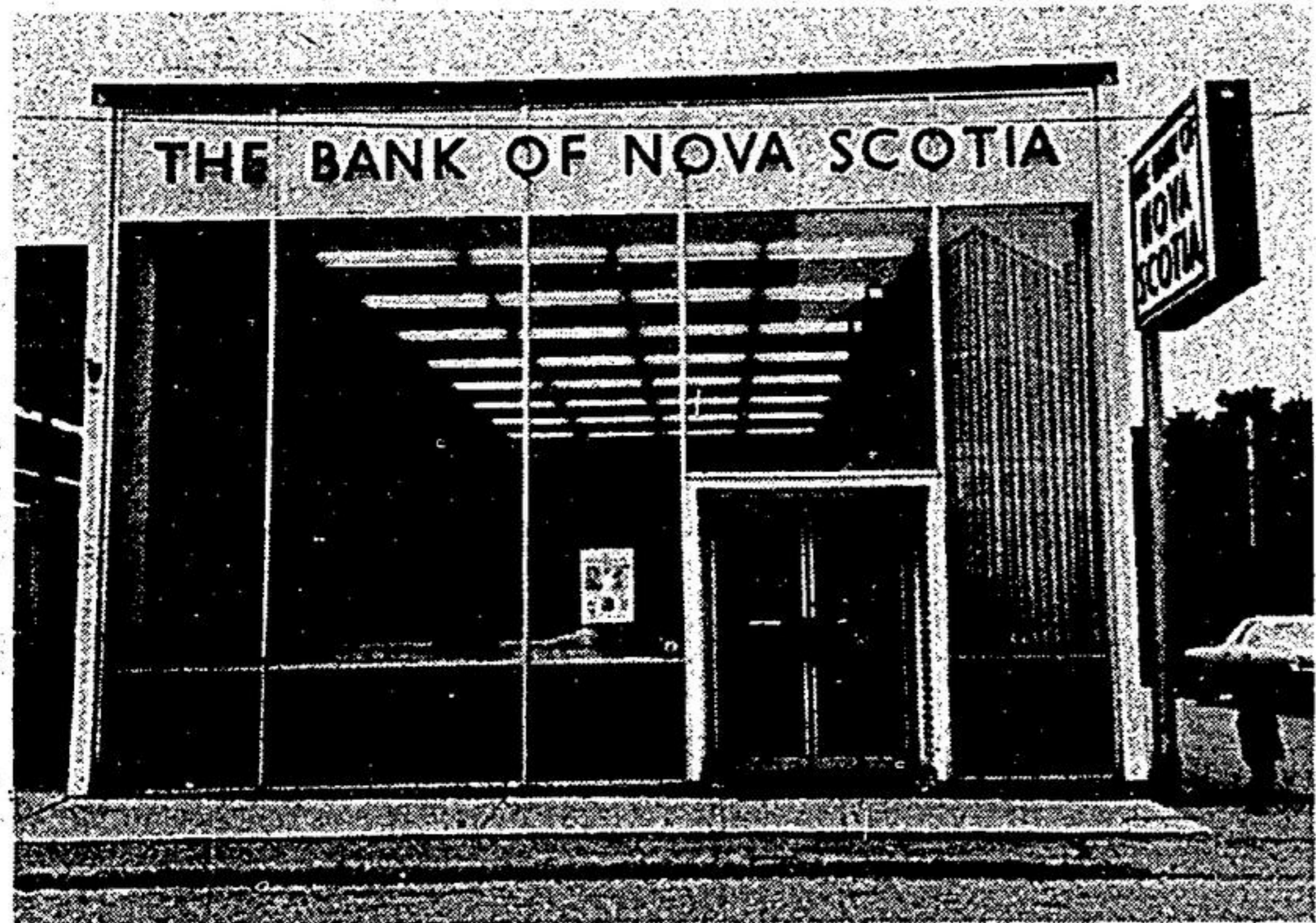

Established in Stouffville 63 year ago.

The Bank of Nova Scotia was first established in Stouffville when it took over the local branch of the Metropolitan Bank in 1914. The branch was managed by Mr. W. R. Adams for a salary of \$1200, the chief clerk received \$500 annually, the ledgerkeeper & the junior clerk earned \$350. & \$200. respectively.

In 1923 the bank moved to the south side of Main Street, the premises were "lighted by hydro-electric and equipped with oak counter fittings".

In 1932 the bank moved again this time to the north side of Main Street and Mr. F. Marshall the manager reported "The bank is housed in a very attractive location better than our competitors".

Today the bank is situated in fine modern premises at 34 Main Street West with a staff of 10 under the management of Mr. P. C. Roney.
