**Notice of PUBLIC MEETING**

in the MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 19 CIVIC AVE., STOUFFVILLE

A public meeting will be held by the Planning Committee of the Town of Whitchurch - Stouffville, as noted above, to discuss the following proposed Official Plan Amendment, whereby it is the intent of Council to:

"Consider proposed amendment No. 15 to the Official Plan of the Township of Whitchurch, now in the Whitchurch - Stouffville planning area, which changes the land use designation from "Rural" to "Estate Residential" on part of LOT 31, CONCESSION 7.

The subject site consisting of approximately 34 acres is located in the southwest corner of Lot 31, Concession 7 approximately 200 to 260 feet north of the VIVIAN SIDEROAD and 200 feet east of the SEVENTH CONCESSION ROAD. The subject site abuts REGISTERED PLANS 377 and 491. The proposed amendment results from an application by C. Lloyd which proposes a 6 lot "estate residential" development."

You are invited to attend the meeting and to state your support or objection to the proposed amendment. Should you be unable to attend, written submission will be received up to the time of the meeting. The amending document may be examined at the Municipal Building, 19 Civic Ave., Stouffville during regular business hours. (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.)
