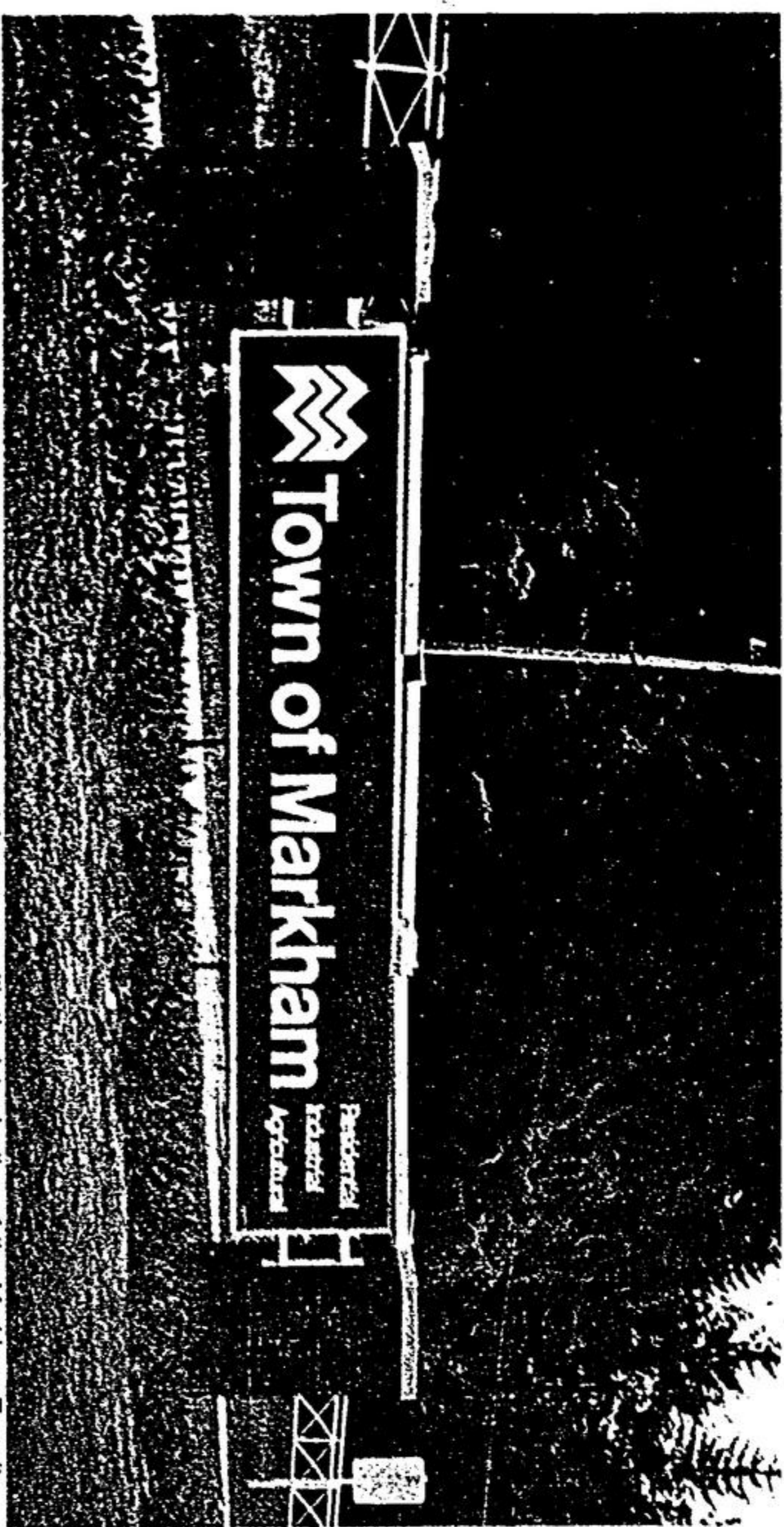


A GREAT PLACE TO LIVE, WORK, TO PLAY ... MARKHAM

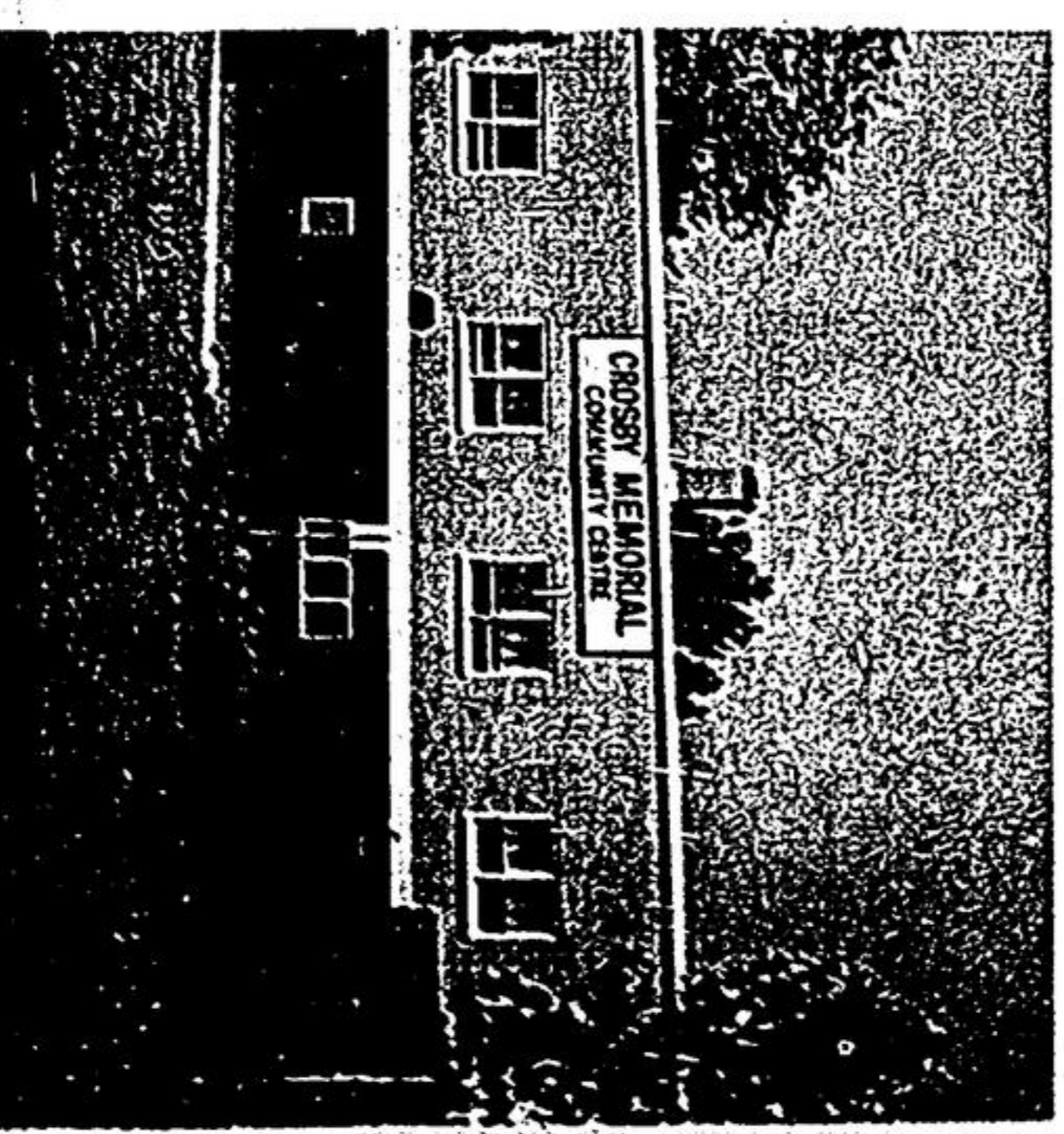
MEETING THE NEEDS OF THE COMMUNITY RECREATION



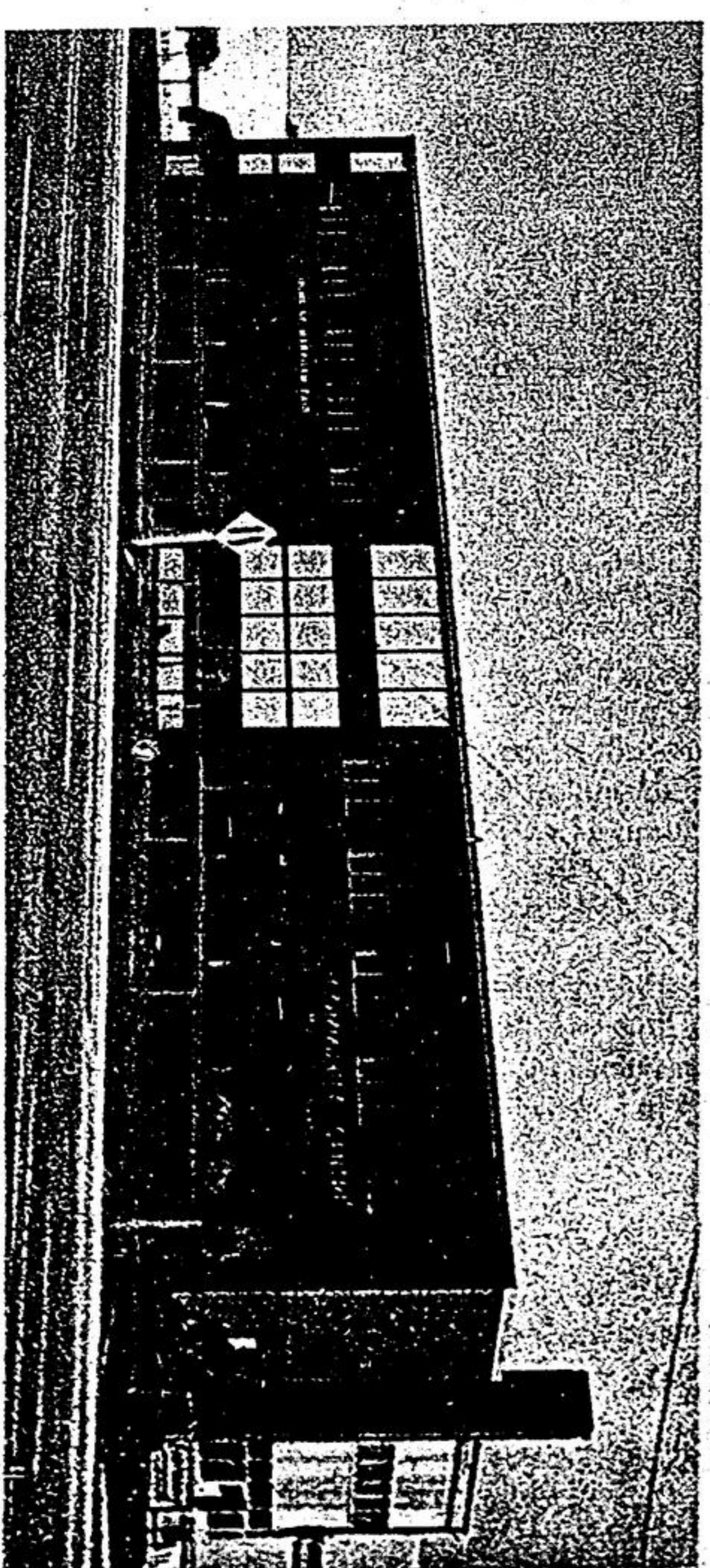
MARKHAM CENTENNIAL CENTRE— Located on McCowan Road, north of Hwy. 7, the centre offers an extensive summer entertainment program featuring popular band concerts and dances, public ice skating and junior hockey in the winter months. Plans are now underway for an addition to the centre which will include a modern swimming pool and fitness complex.



THORNHILL COMMUNITY CENTRE— The centre is located at the corner of John St. and Bayview Ave. in Thornhill and offers some of the finest recreational facilities in Ontario. Designed and built for the people of Markham, Unionville and Thornhill.



GROSSY MEMORIAL ARENA— Located on Kennedy Road in Unionville, the arena was recently renovated by the joint efforts of the local community and the Markham Town Council. It is the home of the Union Skating Club, Unionville Minor Hockey Association, and various power skating and hockey schools.



MARKHAM CENTENNIAL RECREATIONAL AND POOL COMPLEX— The centre is located at the corner of Hwy. 7 and Hwy. 48 in the heart of the Old Town. The centre hosted the Markham Fair since it was constructed in the early 1960's. The centre serves the towns people with winter ice skating and junior hockey, and summer roller skating and various other programs.
