Picton. "There was quite an uproar over that," explained Mr. Doble. The applicant soothed these fears. "Most of our material is preserved in 8 per cent formaldehyde," he said, and added that most specimens that the company processes on the premises are already dead.

However, after hearing him out they decided that rather than a rezoning, he should apply to the Committee of Adjustment for a ruling on a non-conforming use. The building in question which had previously housed World Nature Products and a variety of other businesses, has been empty for some time.
