1. Parents or guardians must be public school supporters.
2. To be eligible for admission in September 1978 children must have been born on or before 1973/12/31. Verification of birthdate and record of immunization are required. Application forms for birth certificates are available in the schools.
3. If a school receives more registrations than it can accommodate, all registrations received before May 1st will be treated equally as far as date of registration is concerned. Registrations received on or after May 1st will be sequenced and the date of registrations will be the criteria used to determine which pupils may be required to attend another school unless there are sufficient volunteers to do so.
