CANADA PENSION PLAN CHANGES.

Better Benefits For Some.

Divorce or Annulment

CPP pension credits earned by a husband and wife during marriage may be divided equally between them if the marriage ends in divorce or annulment after January 1, 1978. This ensures that an asset accumulated through the efforts of both spouses while they were married can be shared equally by both when the marriage is dissolved.

Retroactive Payment of Retirement Benefits.

Retirement benefits may now be paid retroactively for a period of up to 12 months to contributors who had attained age 65 but who are under age 70 and who have retired from the labour force.

Post-Mortem Benefits.

to 12 months) can now be made on behalf of a deceased person, in cases where a contributor qualified, but failed to apply. before death. Families or estates will be entitled to receive benefits in such cases.

Elimination of Reductions

Orphans' and disabled contributors' to receive equal benefits.

His steel blue eyes take on an almost fanatical gleam as he talks about it. Coulter a large, enthusiastic man. is the head of ARCRAD, a fledgling company in Markham that hopes to and market aerogenerators (windmills to you and me) which produce elec-

windspeed, the average home would need at least two and possibly three or four 2500 watt units to provide adequate electrical output for household needs. Coulter (estimates that a system of this type, which would include power plant towers, storage batteries, and an inverter to transform the D.C. current generated into A.C. household current,

at about \$10,000 or \$11,000. Windspeed itself is " not crucial-the ARCRAD machines begin generating power at velocities as low as 7 mph and produce their rated capacities at between 17-22 mph. This means that when the wind is blowing at 17 mph a 1500 watt WINFLOW will be generating 'its rated

output of 1500 watts. At windspeeds higher than that the wattage will stay the same but the amperage will increase. The units can withstand windspeeds of up to 100 mph because of a unique spoiler system which spills out some of the () wind at high velocities. Without the spoiler, the extremely high winds could theoretically drive the wing tip speeds up to Mach 1 (the speed of sound). Such high speeds place enormous stress on the units and are not desirable.

It stands to reason Q then, that the lack of adequate windmonitoring facilities in Canada is one of Philip Coulter's major sources of frustration. "You ask the Department of Natural Resources where all the resources are and they'll tell you. They have maps for oil, gas, everything. But you ask them where the wind is and they say they don't know." Coulter's voice became intense as he continued, "We badly need government support in monitoring wind and solar power. Right now it's like you buying gasoline and not knowing how many mpg you're going to .get."

Maps showing average wind speeds in an area are labelled "useless" by Coulter since high winds might be followed by long periods of calm, thus producing misleading statistics.

Coulter, who conducted the first ever wind energy inventory for the U.S. government in the Florida Keys, has been trying to interest the Canadian government in a similar program for the last five years with absolutely no success. He said that when the government finally agreed that wind inventories should be done they referred him "to the bloody airport". He explained indignantly that not only do airports lack the vital chart recorders needed for accurate monitoring, but they are often in the wrong place as well.

Of course some places (such as coastal areas) are so obviously windy there is no need for monitoring. Also, every area has some wind — if you can get up high enough. At 50 feet up (the minimum tower height recommended by Coulter for his machines) wind speed increases 12 to 20 per cent and by the time () CN tower the wind never stops. Velocities at the top of the tower have never dropped below 30 But the major market

for aerogenerators, in Coulter's view, will be overseas.

"If you think there's 12 an energy crunch in Canada, it's peanuts to what you encounter in primitive countries. A lot of those countries are so poor, they've never had electricity," he explained, . "Our company has a missionary outlook, we help people around the world get electricity for i) the first time."

ARCRAD has already sold some of the low powered (300 watt) machines retailing for under \$1000 to church and missionary groups working in remote places such as Dela Gonave in Haiti.

His company also markets an even smaller unit - the 30 watt Mini-Gen (priced at \$99.50) which comes complete with post, battery and two
