

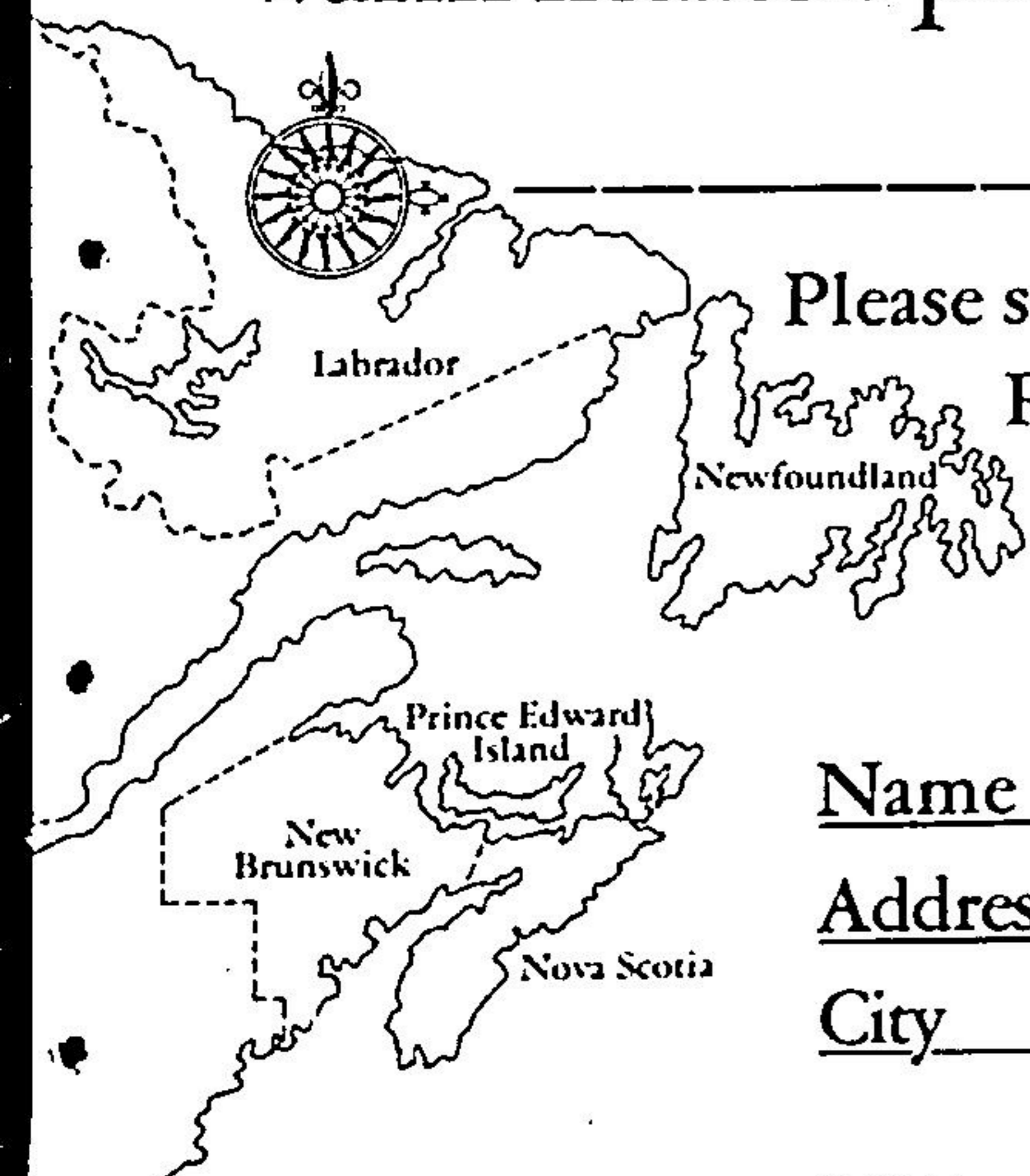
# The Close Coast
