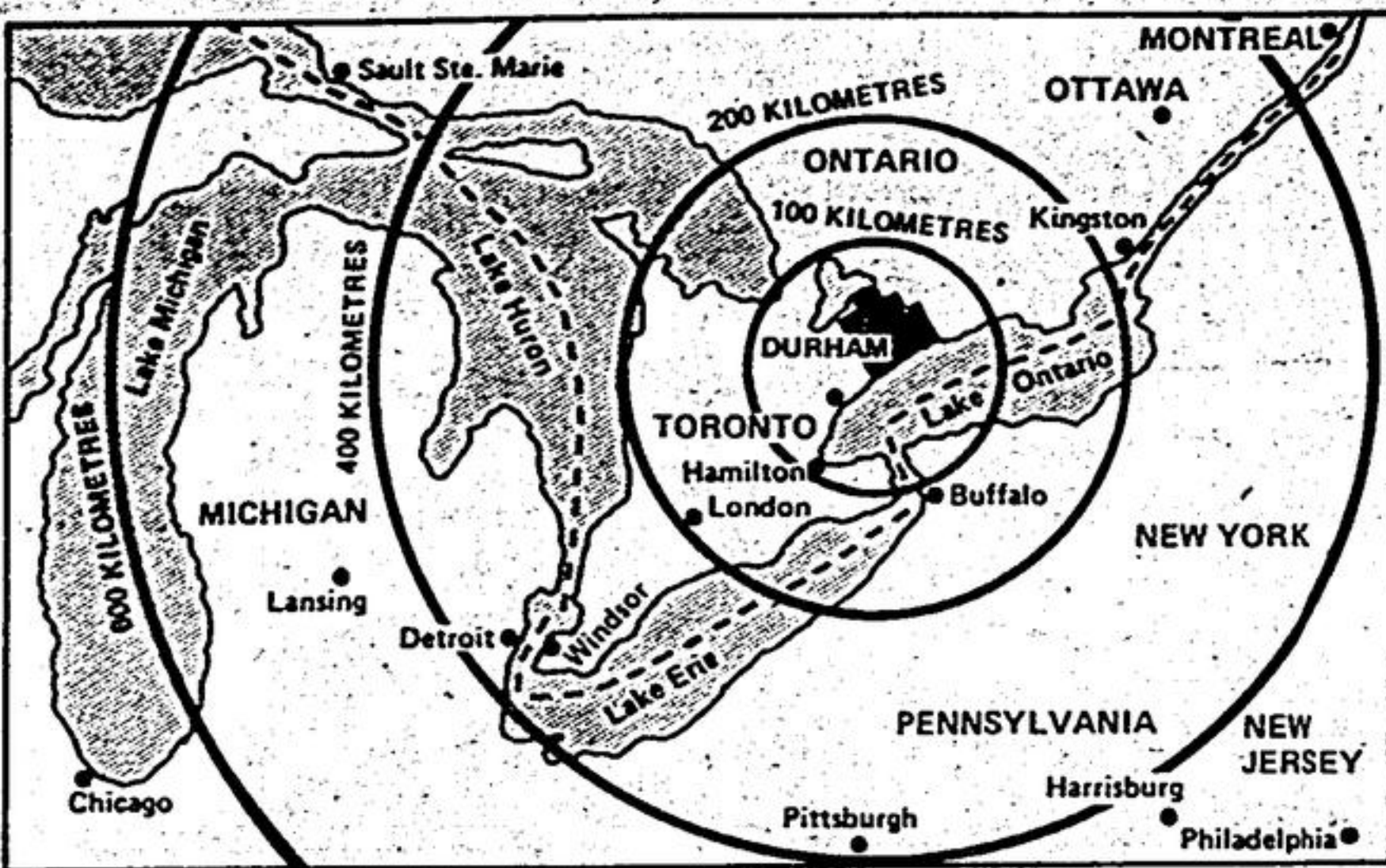

THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION AND HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT ACT ROAD CLOSING

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Ontario Municipal Board has approved the closing of certain roads intersecting the controlled-access Highway No. 404, in the Towns of Richmond Hill and Whitchurch-Stouffville, Regional Municipality of York, as a result of an application by the Minister of Transportation and Communications at a Public Hearing on January 18, 1978 at Toronto.

Claims for compensation for injurious affection with particulars of the claim shall be made within one year after the physical closing of the road and if not so made, the right to said compensation will be forever barred in accordance with Section 22 of The Expropriations Act.

Stouffville scoring was limited to two players. Tony Arrigo opened the scoring with his try. Steve Schell had a big game, collecting the rest of the game points on his try, penalty kick and two converts for a total of 11 points. A try is worth four points; a convert two points.

The Spartans played two games this week, the first against the strong Markham team that many feel will determine the York Championship. And on Wednesday Stouffville went up against the junior All-Ontario champions from Oakwood in an exhibition match. Both game results will be reported in next week's Tribune.

Next Tuesday, May 16, the senior Spartans will be hosting a rugby tournament at SDSS.

The tourney starts at 12 noon with Stouffville squaring off with Monarch Park, last year's Toronto champions.

At 1 p.m. Victoria Park goes up against Whitby Anderson Collegiate.

The two losing teams from the games will play each other at 2:30 p.m.,

while the championship game gets underway at 3:30 p.m. And of course spectators are welcome.

In other rugby news the York County midget and junior rugby championship tournament will be played next Wednesday, May 17 at Fletchers Field, one mile south of Gormley on the Don Mills Road.
